Typically, in a somewhat obligatory fashion, preachers all over the world preach annually on the resurrection of Christ on 'Easter Sunday.'


Today, I want to go against the norm. I shall assume you would not be here if you didn't believe Christ rose from the grave.



1a: a formal written warrant granting the power to perform various acts or duties

2: an authorization or command to act in a prescribed manner or to perform prescribed acts: charge

3a: authority to act for, in behalf of, or in place of another

b: a task or matter entrusted to one as an agent for another

4a: a group of persons directed to perform some duty

5: an act of entrusting or giving authority

When we examine this passage of Scripture we see that the only imperative in the v. is to “make disciples.”

Go, baptize, and teach are all subordinate participles to the imperative verb *mathēteuō* Μαθητεύω translated make disciples.

**In order to know if we

Notice I am not asking you

If you are a Baptist?

If you are an evangelical?

If you are a conservative?

If you are a Protestant?

**I am asking: Are you a disciple
of Jesus Christ?**

First, let's be clear—we see NO distinction in the NT between believers and disciples or Christians and disciples.

Disciples are not level 2, 3, or 4 Christians.

How do we know this?



No distinction

- The last reference to disciple(s) in the NT is found in Acts 21:16
- Nothing in the NT indicates a distinction between disciple and saint or disciple and Christian or disciple and believer
- You may be more of a disciple of Christ or less of a disciple, but if you are not a disciple of Christ you are NOT a Christian

Disciple Defined



- 1: one who accepts and assists in spreading the doctrines of another: as**
 - a: one of the twelve in the inner circle of Christ's followers according to the Gospel accounts**
 - b: a convinced adherent of a school or individual**
- 2: capitalized: a member of the Disciples of Christ founded in the U.S. in 1809 that holds the Bible alone to be the rule of faith and practice, usually baptizes by immersion, and has a congregational polity**



Synonyms for Disciple

- Student
- Pupil
- Learner
- Follower
- Believer
- Zealot
- Adherent

For the follower of Christ there is a necessary supernatural spiritual component to being a disciple.



Luke 19:10

- **For the Son of man [Jesus] is come to seek and to save that which was lost.**

Lost describes the fallen state of all humans who need to be saved from their sin and the wrath of God.

Making Disciples

Is **not** like the teacher student relationship in martial arts or any other discipline.

Born-Again Defined

Born-again is an expression used by Jesus (John 3) to describe a spiritual rebirth or regeneration performed by the Holy Spirit such that a sinner is no longer an unbeliever alienated and separated from God.



1 Corinthians 12:3

Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus is accursed!” **and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except in the Holy Spirit.**


In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.



Acts 16:30-31

- Then he brought them out and said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”
- And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.”

Romans 10:8–17

⁸ But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, **the word of faith** that we proclaim); ⁹ because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord **and believe** in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one **believes** and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, “Everyone who **believes in him** will not be put to shame.” ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. ¹³ For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” ¹⁴ How then will they call on him in whom they have **not believed**? And how are they to **believe in him** of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? ¹⁵ And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” ¹⁶ But they have not all obeyed **the gospel**. For Isaiah says, “Lord, **who has believed** what he has heard from us?” ¹⁷ So **faith** comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.



My Two Takeaways

1. God must do a supernatural work in the spiritual heart of the unbeliever to become a believer.
2. The unbeliever must believe the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ to be saved.

How these two truths co-exist is a mystery to me...!?




John 1:11-13

Matthew 16:13-17

- Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?”
14 And they said, “Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.” 15 He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” 16 Simon Peter replied, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”
17 And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven.

Disciple's Believe

This about Jesus' Work

- He lived a sinless life in order to die for their own sins on a cross
- He was buried and rose again on the third day to validate the authenticity of His Person and the efficacy of his Work
- He is presently interceding on their behalf
- He is coming again

- The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!


