

To the Saints at Philippi

¹ Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons: ² Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. ³ I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, ⁴ Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, 5 For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now; ⁶ Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ: 7 Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace. 8 For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ. ⁹ And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; 10 That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; ¹¹ Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.







Is literally "Holy Ones"


 Christians have been made holy by the blood of Jesus Christ and are expected to live holy lives



Grace from God




Grace Defined

Why is Paul thanking God for these saints at Philippi?




Philippians 1:5 (ESV)






Philippians 1:6 (ESV)

Our salvation begins and ends with the Lord.




Salvation Fact



You will not develop this affection for other brothers and sisters in Christ if you don't know their names why do you think Berean put such emphasis on connecting with people?











Grace Defined


God's goodness toward those who deserve only punishment.

And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, With knowledge and all discernment,






Philippians 1:10 (ESV)

The words of Jesus in John 15 bring great clarity to this text from Paul.



John 15:4-5

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you [bear fruit], unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. 1967 - 2017

Hebrews 12:11 (AV)

Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.





Philippians 1:11 (ESV)

- filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ,
- to the glory and praise of God.



Fruit of Righteousness

- Spirit of Generosity / absence of selfishness
- Work Ethic / absence of slothfulness
- Kindness toward others/ absence of rudeness
- Personal purity / absence of promiscuity
- Appropriate language/ absence of vulgarity
- Integrity and honesty / absence of dishonesty
- Contentment / absence of covetousness



Galatians 5:22-23 (NET)

- But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- Against such things there is no law.
