## Revelation 2:1–7 (AV)

<sup>1</sup> Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks; <sup>2</sup> I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars: <sup>3</sup> And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted. <sup>4</sup> Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. <sup>5</sup> Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. <sup>6</sup> But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. <sup>7</sup> He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

**We must look at each and every letter and analyze it as though it was potentially written to us.**

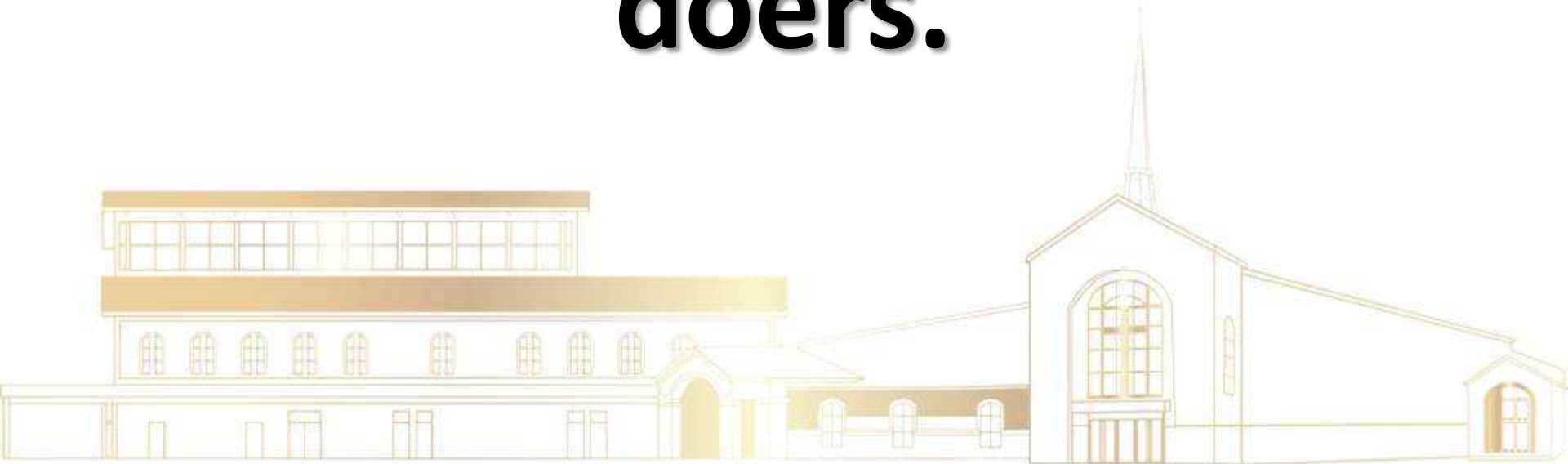
**We MUST care about what Christ would think about Berean.**

# Revelation 2:3



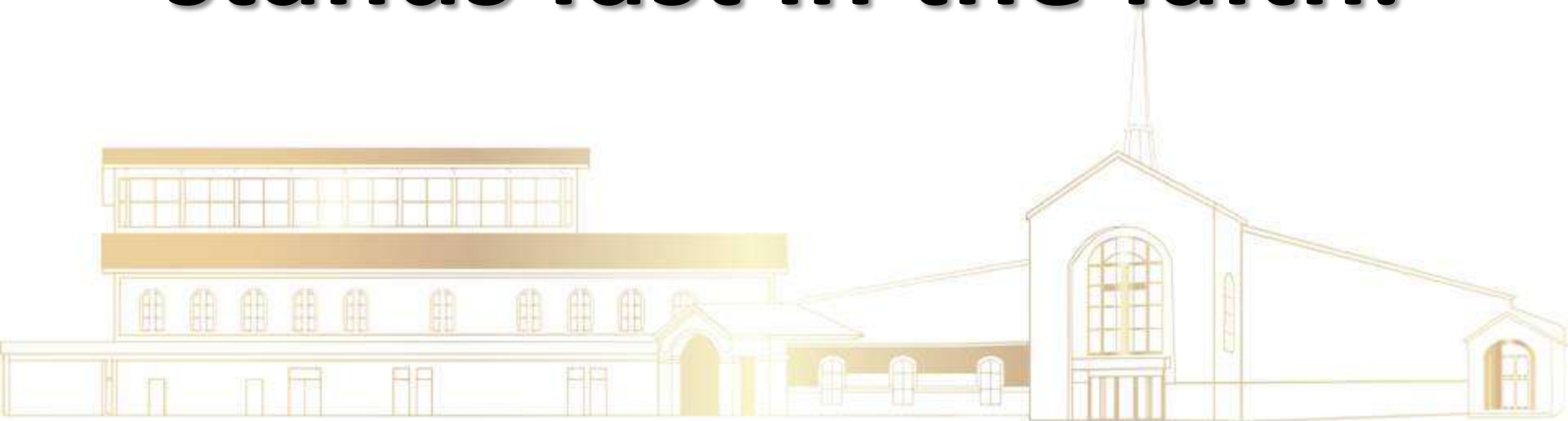
- I know you are enduring patiently

are evil,



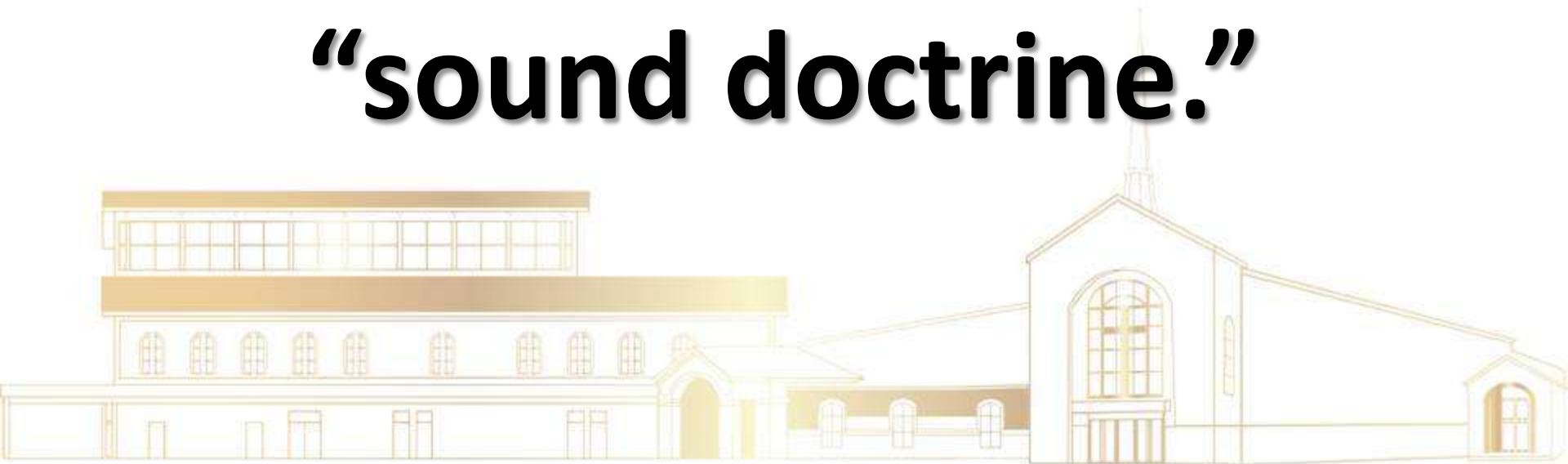
**Every reference to “evil”

requires CRITERIA.**





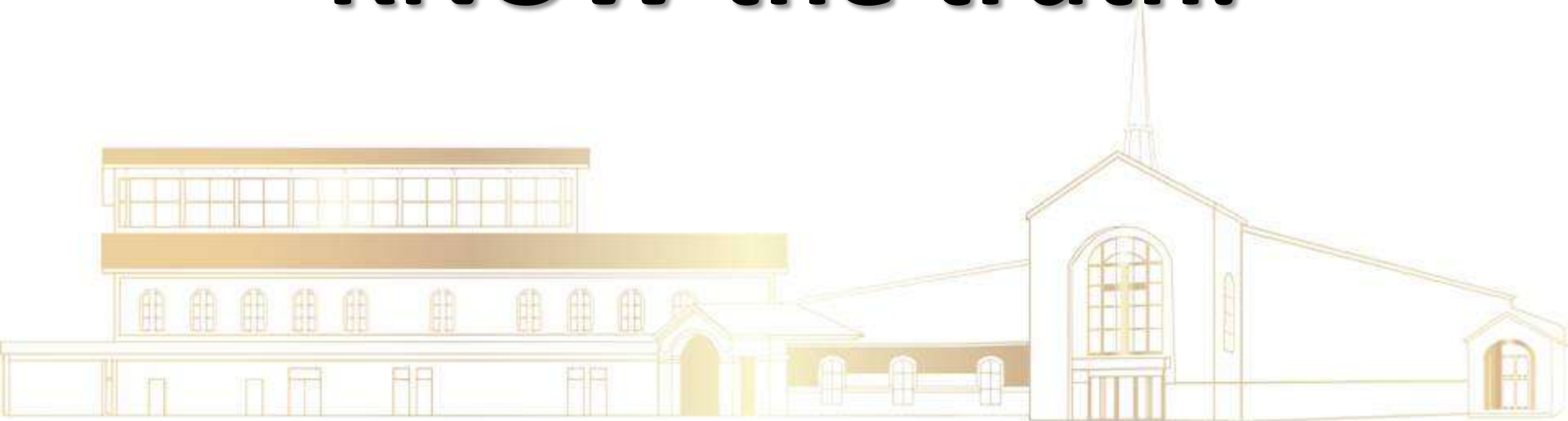
# **Criteria for Doctrinal Examination**

- **Tri-Unity of the Godhead**
- **Inerrancy and Infallibility of the Word of God**
- **Person and Work of Jesus Christ**
- **Means by which Salvation is Obtained & Secured**
- **Purpose of the Ordinances Baptism & Lord's Supper**



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**In order to examine  
false teachers we must  
KNOW the truth.**



# Doctrine Matters

- Jesus the one and only eternal Son of God, second person of the TRI-UNE God
- **Supernatural conception; virgin birth**
- Sinless life in perfect obedience to the will of His one and only Father
- **Substitutionary death & Legitimate burial**
- Bodily resurrection
- **Post resurrection/pre-ascension ministry**
- Ascension
- **Mediatorial (Intercessional) ministry**
- Second Coming

# Revelation 2:4

**What does he  
mean by  
abandoned the  
love you had at  
first?**



**2:4–5 the love you had at first.** One interpretation is that Ephesus had lost its early love for Christ. Another interpretation is that Ephesian believers had lost love for one another and needed to revive the compassionate works you did at first. Many interpreters think both are in view, since love for Christ and love for one another are related (cf. Mark 12:29–31; 1 John 4:20).

# John 21:15-17

- When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Feed my lambs.” <sup>16</sup> He said to him a second time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Tend my sheep.” <sup>17</sup> He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?” Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, “Do you love me?” and he said to him, “Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.”

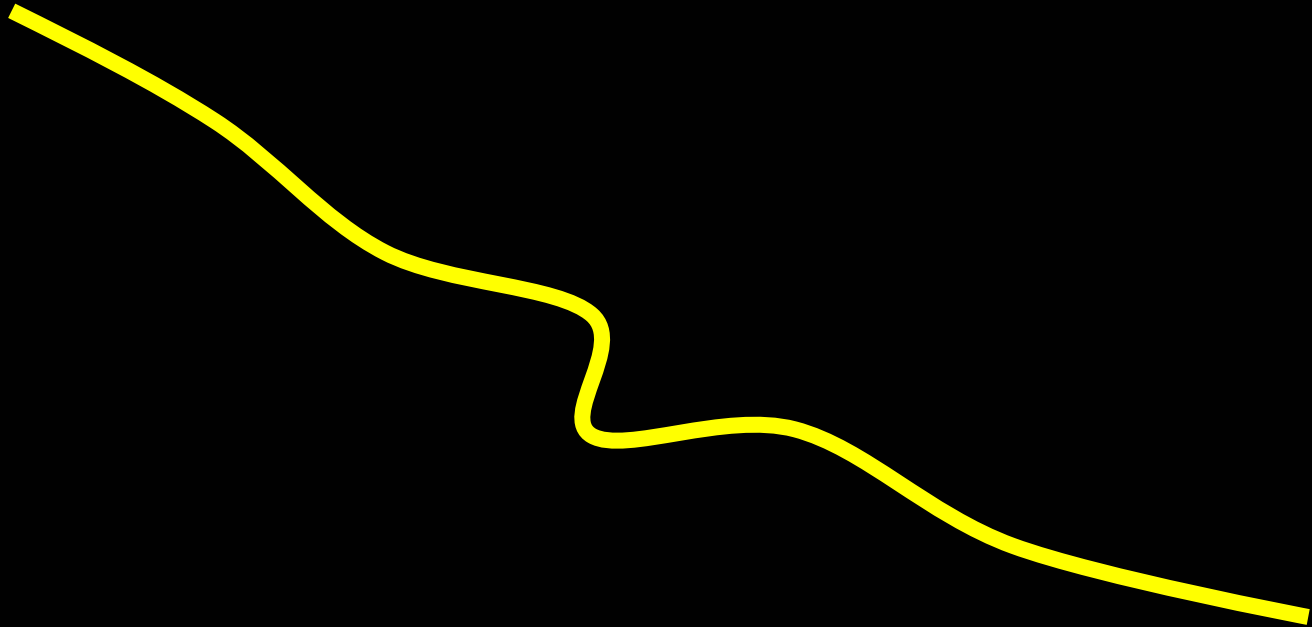
**Baptists have decided the

# 1 Corinthians 11:23–25

- <sup>23</sup> For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, <sup>24</sup> and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, “This is my body, which is for you. **Do this in remembrance of me.**” <sup>25</sup> In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood. **Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.**”

# Revelation 2:5



- **If not,** I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.

**“Removing the lampstand”** is the act of Christ that moves a local body of Christ into a club—an organized gathering place for like-minded religious socialites.

These religious socialites pacify their conscience through charitable acts of benevolence and routine religious rites and rituals.



# Revelations 2:6



- Yet this you have:
- you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

**Notice they do not hate the Nicolaitans [Muslims]—they hate the works, the deeds, the practice of the Nicolaitans.**

**I must continually guard my heart.**

**I must be able to distinguish between the person and the deeds of the person.**



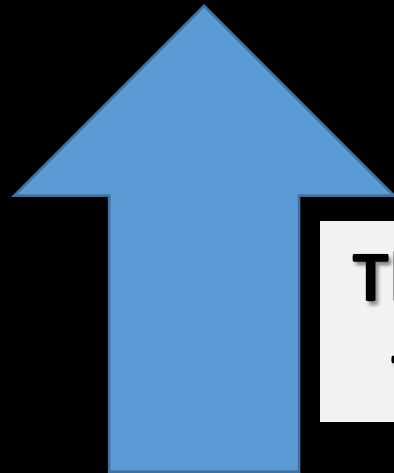
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your impertinence.
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your homosexuality.
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your acts of terror.
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your egotistic arrogance.
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your self-centeredness.
- > It is not you that I hate—it is your effeminacy.
