**<sup>10</sup> That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; <sup>11</sup> Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.**

# 1 Corinthians 8:13

Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

ESV

Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.



**The purpose of developing a biblical worldview is to minimize the judgment I will receive when I must give an account for the life I lived.**

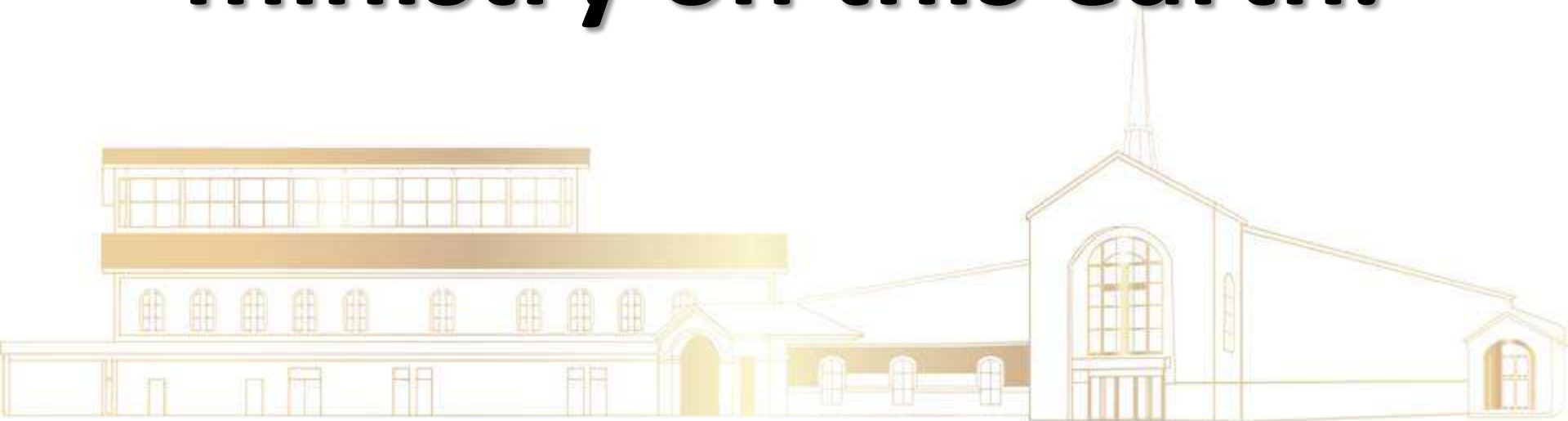

## Matthew 7:15–19 (ESV)

“Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. <sup>16</sup> You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? <sup>17</sup> So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. <sup>18</sup> A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. <sup>19</sup> **Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.**



# Matthew 7

## Verse 20

Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

**Does this apply to just the false teachers or everyone?**



# Matthew 12:33-35

Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: **for the tree is known by his fruit.** <sup>34</sup> O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. <sup>35</sup> A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

# Again Jesus teaches on bearing Fruit

## John 15



**“I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. <sup>2</sup> Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. <sup>3</sup> Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you.**

**<sup>4</sup> Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.**

**What does it mean to  
abide in Christ?**

# Abide

- Believe in and continue to believe
- **Submit to Christ's authority and revealed will for my life**
- Yield to his ownership of my body, mind and soul
- **Follow his commandments and strive to apply what he taught to my worldview**
- Rely or lean upon Christ for my sustainment and strength



**<sup>5</sup> I am the vine; you are the branches.**

**Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.**

**<sup>6</sup> If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned.**

# Degrees of Fruitfulness

- All true Christians bear some fruit
- **Some Christians bears more fruit**
- Fewer Christians bear much fruit

Mark 4:20

Describes some fruit, more fruit, and much fruit



# Mark 4:20

But those that were sown on  
the good soil are the ones  
who hear the word and  
accept it and bear fruit,  
thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a  
hundredfold.”



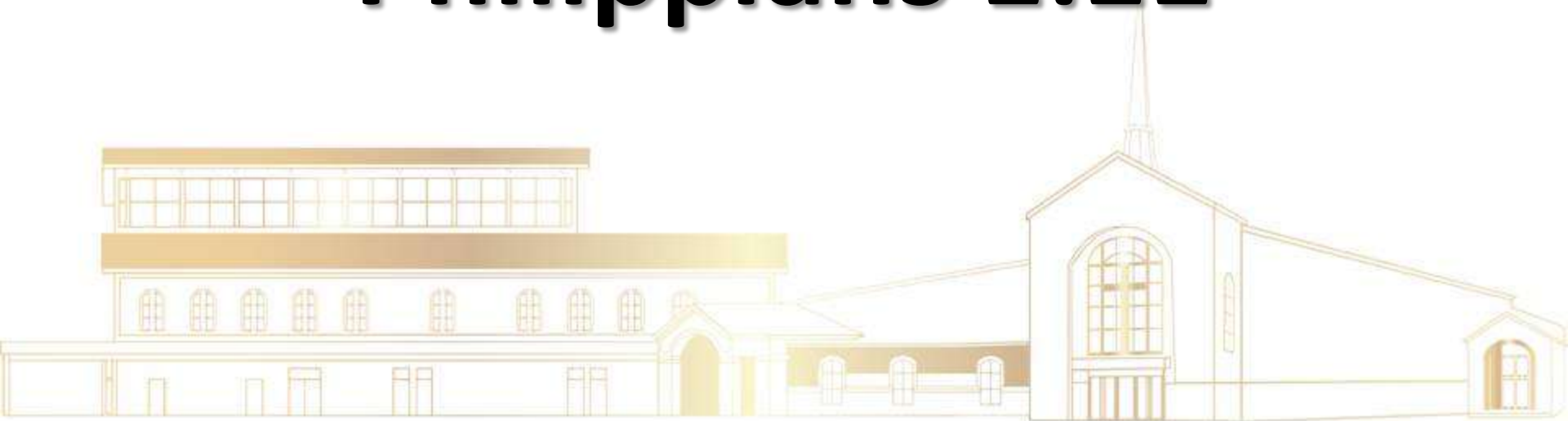
**<sup>8</sup> By this my Father is glorified,  
that you bear much fruit and  
so prove to be my disciples.**

**Notice Jesus doesn't say saved or born again.  
That is NOT the focus of the NT.**

**The focus on the NT goes beyond saved—the  
Apostles were committed to creating  
followers of Jesus Christ.**



**Hebrews 12:11 USES the  
same expression as  
Philippians 1:11**



# Hebrews 12:11 (AV)

Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable **fruit of righteousness** unto them which are exercised thereby.



# Hebrews 12:11 (ESV)

For the moment all discipline  
seems painful rather than  
pleasant,  
but later it yields the peaceful  
fruit of righteousness to  
those who have been trained  
by it.



**If Paul is using the  
expression like the author  
of Hebrews then we are  
talking about behavior.**





# Philippians 1:11 (ESV)

- **filled with the fruit of righteousness**

don't think so.**

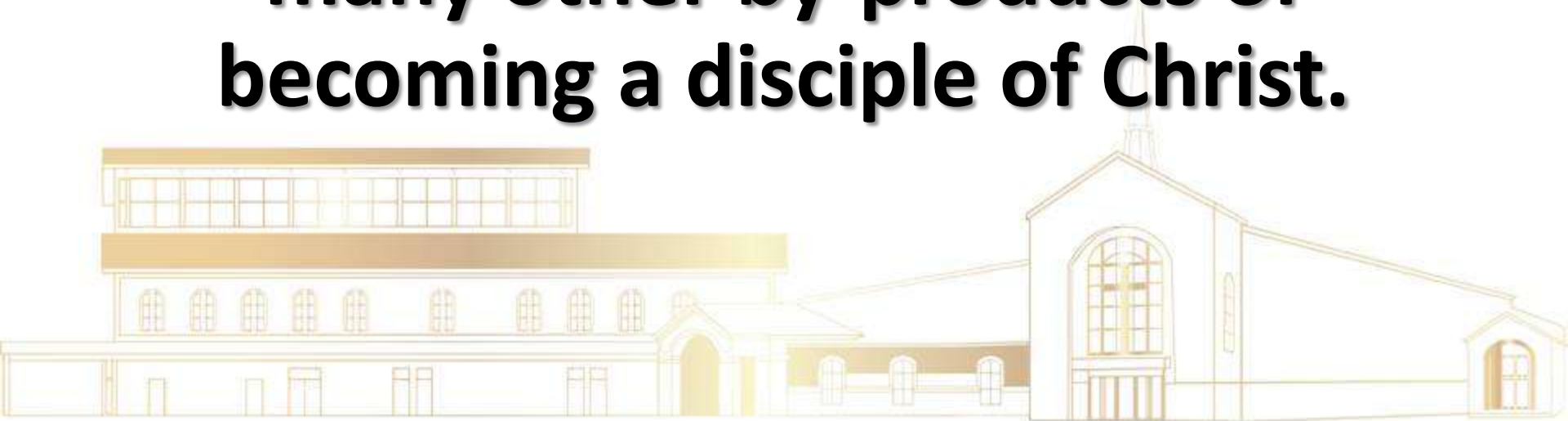




# Galatians 5:22–23 (NET)

- But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- Against such things there is no law.

**I think fruit of righteousness includes the fruit of the Spirit but is NOT limited to just the fruit of the Spirit because Paul addresses many other by-products of becoming a disciple of Christ.**

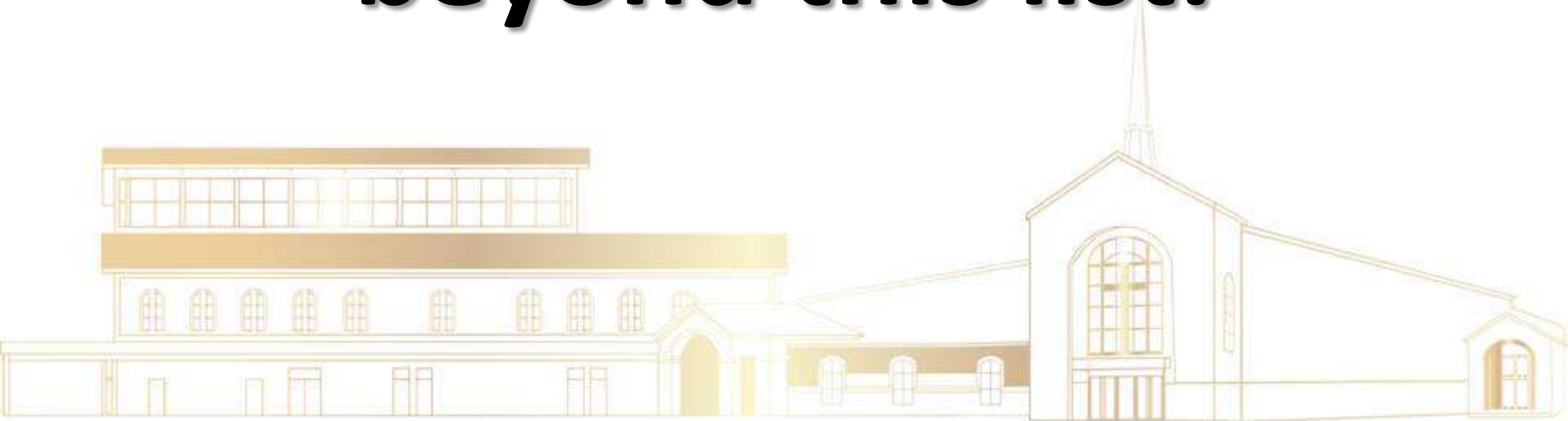

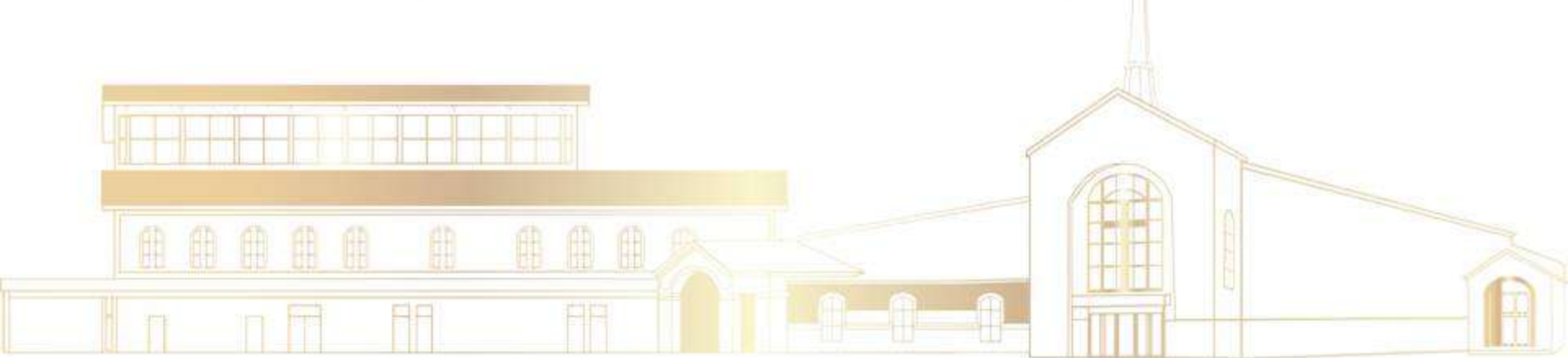


# 1 Timothy 5:8

- But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.



**New Christian 'A' recognizes a lack of a work ethic present in their life and through the power of the Spirit begins to manifest the fruit of a work ethic.**



# Ephesians 4:28

Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
