Hears v. Sees is important language.

The description of Christ in Revelation 5 immediately alerts me into the reality that I will not be able to interpret Revelation like I do other books.

A lion/lamb with 7 horns and 7 eyes is NOT normative.

When he opened the sixth seal, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake, and the sun became black as sackcloth, the full moon became like blood, ¹³ and the stars of the sky fell to the earth as the fig tree sheds its winter fruit when shaken by a gale. ¹⁴ The sky vanished like a scroll that is being rolled up, and every mountain and island was removed from its place. ¹⁵ Then the kings of the earth and the great ones and the generals and the rich and the powerful, and everyone, slave and free, hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains, ¹⁶ calling to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who is seated on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb, ¹⁷ for the great day of their wrath has come, and who can stand?””

Recursive Parallelism

Rev 6:16—wrath

calling to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who is seated on the throne, and **from the wrath of the Lamb.**”

19:15—wrath

From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. **He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.**

7:17—wipe

For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water, and **God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”**

21:4—wipe

He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.”

Revelation 12:1–2



- And a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. ² She was pregnant and was crying out in birth pains and the agony of giving birth.

This woman symbolically represents ALL the people of God in agony. She is:

- **Eve promised an offspring and enmity with the ancient serpent.**
- **Israel described as both pregnant, the bride of God and in pain and agony.**
- **Mary who gives birth to the Messiah.**
- **The church described as the bride of Christ and persecuted by dragon.**



The Woman of Revelation 12

- 1. Eve the woman given the snake crusher birth promise**
- 2. Israel the true people of God in OT**
- 3. Mary the woman who gave birth to the Messiah**
- 4. The church the true people of God in the NT**

The four: Eve, Israel, Mary, and the church all experience pain, agony, sorrow, and suffering.

Progressive Parallelism



Revelation 12:3



- And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great red dragon, with seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven diadems.

Revelation 12:9



- **And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.**

- The dragon makes war on the saints
- The dragon gives power to the beast
- The beast makes war on the saints
- The earth dwellers worship the dragon and the beast
- Both the dragon and beast have a limited amount of time to make war against the saints
- The saints are those who have their names written in the book of life of the Lamb
- The reality of the war against the saints means some are going to be taken captive and some will die by the sword
- **The 'suck of life' on the earth with the beast and dragon requires great steadfast endurance and faith in God, His Christ, the gospel, and the Bible by all the saints**

Revelation 13:10



- If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. **Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints.**

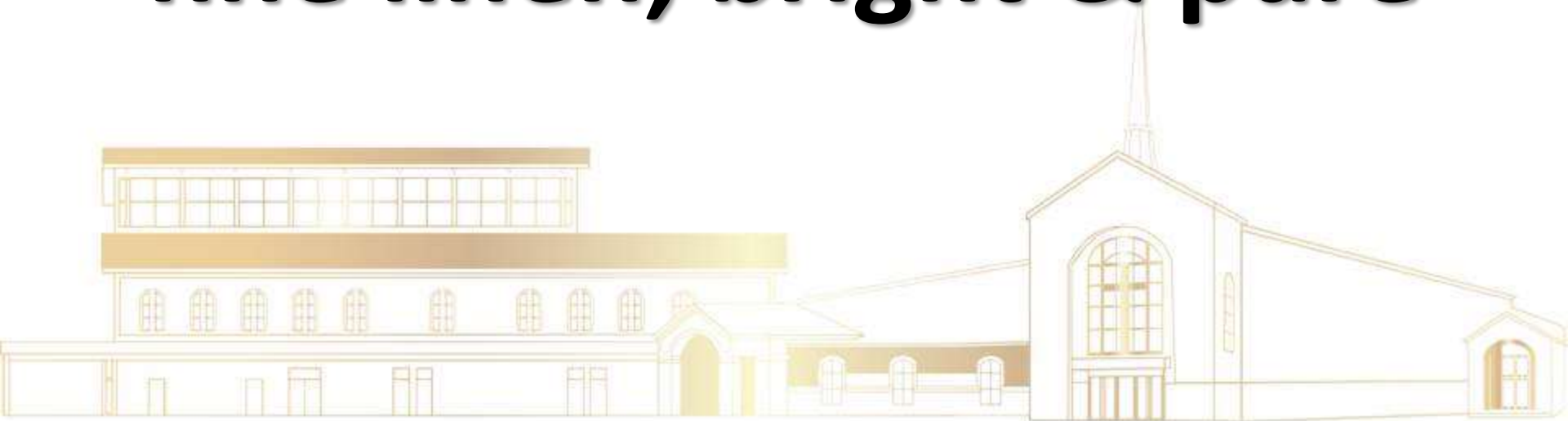

Jesus is Coming Again
