God has been so good and faithful in providing opportunities in the ministry! The last several months have been busy months for us. We have continued things that we have done in the past and we have been able to begin some new things in the present and for the future.

On The Road: In February I returned for the 19th year to Romania, conducting Bible Institute course in Tinca, Gepiu and Stei. We have now brought the Institute in Stei to the point of a graduation with the students receiving a Bachelor's Degree. This will be done in May where my partner, Walter Stevens, will preach the graduation. We are so excited at what God has allowed us to accomplish! The institute in Tinca continues in what is now the fourth round of courses. I am so thankful for my translator, Mirci Pricop, for his leadership in this ministry. In March I was busy preaching and presenting the ministry in West Virginia and Florida.

Also in March we held the second session of an exciting new ministry. I have been able, by God's Grace, to teach a series of one day seminars to 25 Indian Gypsy Pastors via the internet. These men are hungry for instruction from God's Word. Many of them have not been able to have formal teaching and are weak in some areas. Brother Maloth Ravinder is the Indian Gypsy Pastor that I have been working with over the past year. He suggested and helped organized this series of lessons.



Each session has an expense of \$300 for food and printed lessons. We are scheduled for a seminar each month through the end of the year. Any assistance with the financial aspect of this ministry would be appreciated. Donations can be sent to ROMA with "India Project" in the memo line.

On the Home Front: Life at home continues to be blessed by God. All our health issues seem to be under control. Not gone but under control. So far nothing keeps us from fulfilling the work that God has laid out for us. Our son, Sean ran/walked the Gate River Run. That is a nine mile course through Jacksonville. Eileen and I are planning a special June get away to celebrate our 50th anniversary. It's been a great 50 years!

In the Works: Over the summer months we will be back in Romania for the Institute graduation (that is in May). We will also find ourselves in Central America in July. There are plans to return to Romania in September and perhaps a trip into Ukraine at the same time. India is also in the works for a visit. Keep us in your prayers concerning the coming ministry plans.
