The last three months have been very busy with travel and ministry. Yet, God has enabled us to do so much for His kingdom. We serve such an awesome God! I am reminded of something that I would tell new missionaries. *“God never asks us to do anything that He doesn’t empower us to do.”*

Here is the update soon the ministry that God has entrusted to us.

On The Road: In August God used us in three churches here in the state of Florida: 1) Landmark Baptist Church in Bushnell with my friend Pastor Jeff Ledbetter, 2) Victory Baptist Church in Eustis with Pastor Tim Maness and 3) Heritage Baptist Church in Melbourne with Pastor Rylan Millett. God blessed in each of the churches, as we were able to be a help, a blessing and a challenge for missions.

September found me, once again, back in Eastern Europe. We restarted our institute (EEGBI) in Tinca, Romania with Ghita Fekete and Mirci Pricop and a new batch of students. I taught on salvation and the Holy Spirit. We also took a trip into the southwestern corner of Ukraine where we (Ghita, Mirci, Walter Steven and I) distributed food packages and preached in a large Gypsy church (attendance of over 500). What a blessing to minister to so many Roma people at one time. The next stop was in Sofia, Bulgaria where Walter and I took part in a mission conference hosted by Missionary Jonathan Owens. This brother is doing a great work amongst the Roma population of Sofia and we were blessed to have a part in his ministry. The last stop was an institute session in Stei, Romania with my dear friend, Virol Balaciu. We are drawing close to completing our course of study there with plans to start the next round of studies with new students.

In October I was once again on the road in the U.S. traveling to Beverly, WV and the Tygart Valley Baptist Church with Pastor Jack Howell, then to Hesperia, CA and the Mt View Baptist Church for a mission conference with Pastor Rick Stonestreet. Next stop was in St Amant, LA and the St Amant Baptist Church for a mission conference with pastor Chuck Smith. Finally, I was able to fill the pulpit for ROMA’s sponsoring church, Bible Baptist Church in Bradenton, FL. God blessed in all of these meetings with each mission conference seeing an increase in their missions commitments.

On the Home Front: We had a special blessing in August as my brother, Ted, paid us a week long visit. What a blessing to spend time with family. We were able to take him to the Kennedy Space Center and then he joined us for my meeting at Heritage Baptist Church in Melbourne. Sean is back to 100% after his battle with COVID and he was given a promotion at his job. He is now the manager of his own store (gas station). What a blessing!

In the Works: Please pray concerning something that I have on my heart. I have been doing an online Bible study with a Gypsy pastor in India and he is interested in doing some institute training with several fellow Roma pastors in his area. I hope to visit him and survey the need sometime in January. Please pray for these plans to come to fruition.
