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What is Discipleship?

Christian discipleship is the lifelong process by which believers of Jesus intentionally help other believers become mature followers of Jesus, teaching them to know Christ, obey His Word, live like Him, and make disciples themselves.

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<i>Life-long process</i>	Not “one and done.” The focus is on progress not perfection.	Romans 8:29 “...he also predestined us to be conformed to the image of his Son..”	2 Corinthians 3:18 “...being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory.”
<i>Disciples intentionally help others become mature disciples, teaching them to know Christ, to obey His Word</i>	A chain reaction occurs: From Paul to Timothy. From Timothy to other believers.	2 Timothy 2:2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.	Colossians 1:28 He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.
<i>Live like Him</i>	2 Peter 3:18 Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.	Romans 8:29 Conformed to the image of Christ	Ephesians 4:22-24 Put on the new self, created after the likeness of God.
<i>Make disciples themselves</i>	The Great Commission Matt 28:19-20 Therefore go and make disciples...	Matt 4:19 “Come follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.”	

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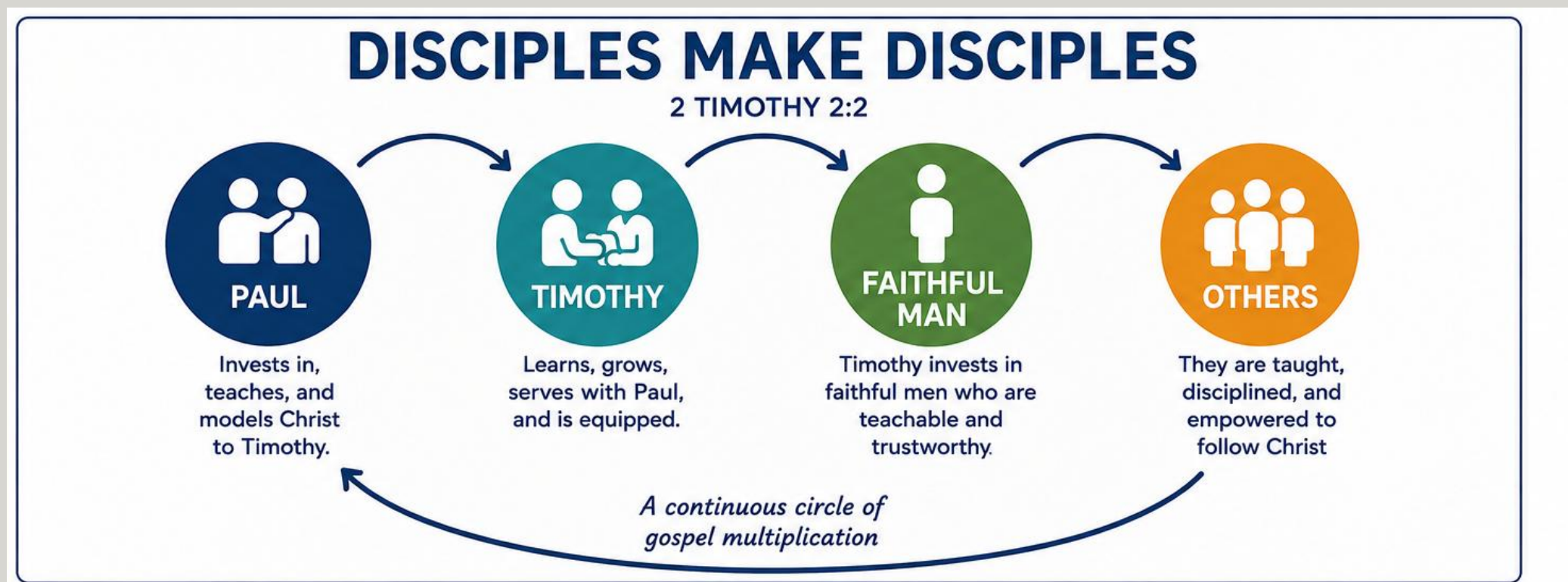
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Five Facets of Discipleship

- Relationships
- Teaching/Spiritual Growth
- Obedience
- Multiplication

The Pattern We Will Work Through:



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1. Relationship: Paul's and Timothy's

Acts 16:1-4 They meet and start building a relationship

- Paul is a believer.
- Timothy is already a believer, "a disciple." (2 Timothy 1:5)
- Male is discipling male.
- Paul was already training him.
- Pronoun "they" showing Paul was training/modeling to Timothy.
"They delivered to them for observation the decisions that had been reached by the apostles and elders who were in Jerusalem."

Reflect: Within Discipleship Relationships, Who Are You?

Paul (the discipler)

Ultimately we are called to do both, as Titus 2 women,

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2 & 3 Teaching and Spiritual Growth: Paul to Timothy

1 Timothy 4:6-16

Paul is instructing Timothy about how to approach the Ephesians.

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We see two paragraphs of Paul instructing Timothy on how he should be shaped by the gospel and how he should speak certain truths to the Ephesian believers.

He gave Timothy specifics:

- * *...be trained in the words of faith and of the good doctrine... v6*
- * *...have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths rather train yourself for godliness...v7*
- * *...devote yourself to public reading v13*
- * *...do not neglect the gift you have v14*

Spiritual Focuses as a Discipler/One Being Disciplined

Ask yourself:

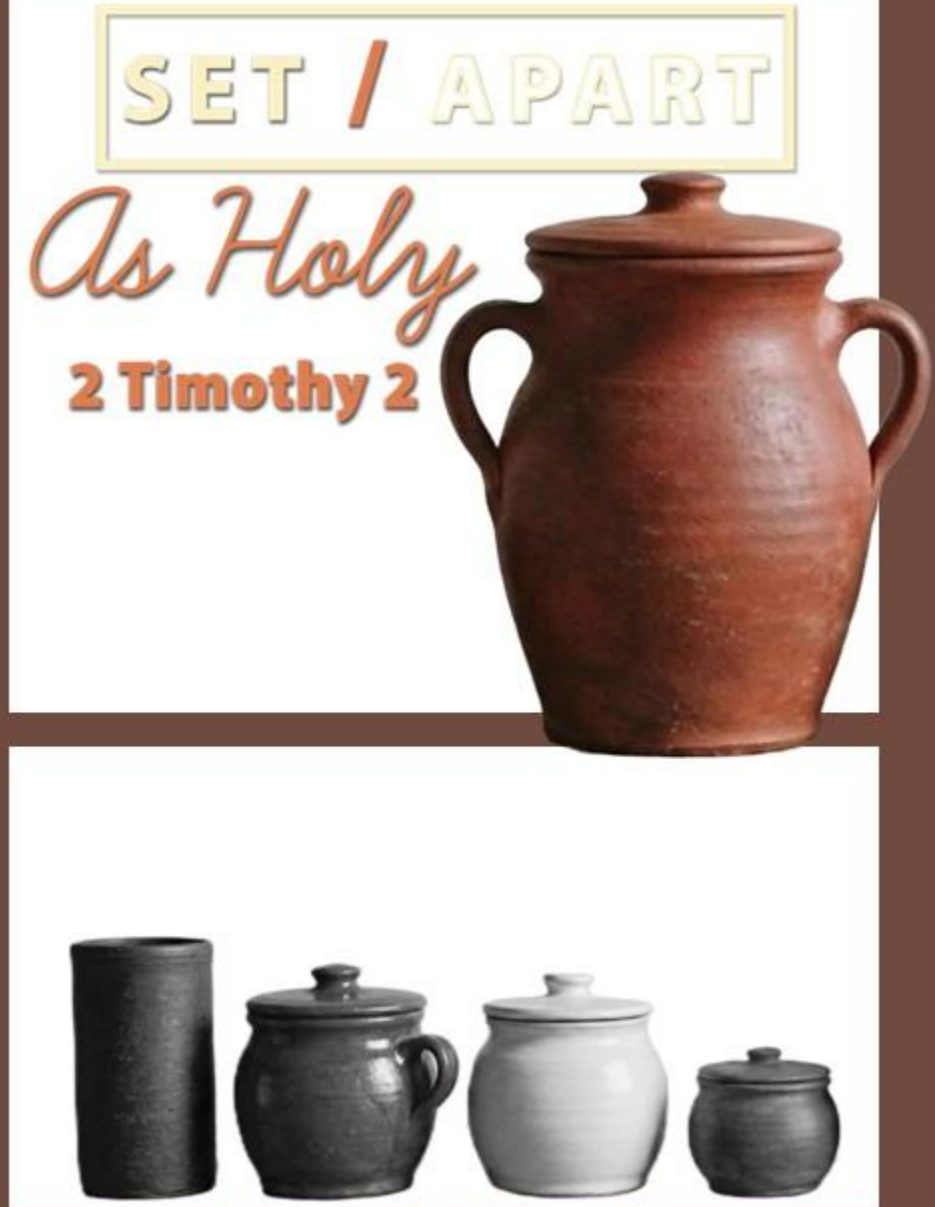
What fruit of the spirit needs work? (Galatians 6)

How can I grow more into a Proverbs 31 woman?

What do I need to "put off" and instead "put on"? (Col 3:5-14)

How do I grow as a godly wife or mother?

How do I represent God in the workplace?



4. Obedience: Timothy's Response

As a **result** of Timothy's discipleship with Paul, he then put into action what he learned.

"You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is Christ Jesus. And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses **entrust to reliable people** who will also be qualified to teach others."

2 Timothy 2:1

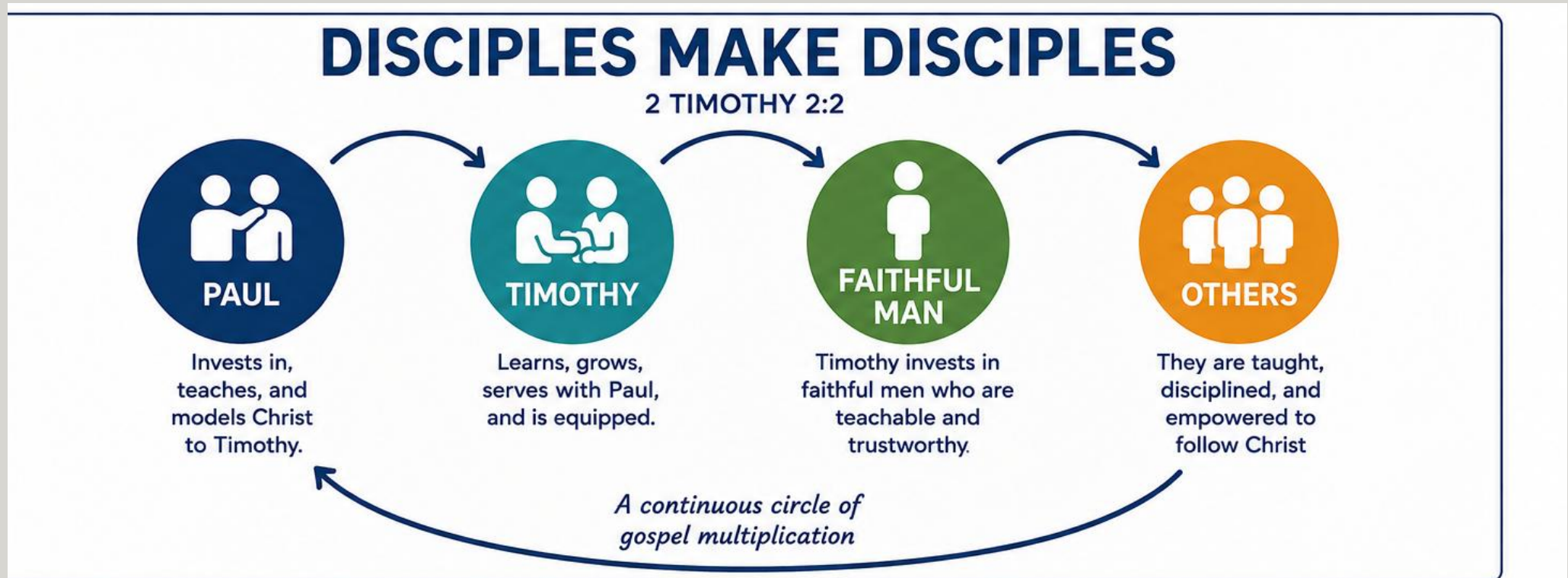
5. Multiplication: From discipled to discipling

2 Timothy 2:2

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

Moving from teaching—obedience to what is taught—to telling others (multiplication).
