- touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.





John 10:27



Christ's all-sufficient Righteousness is obtained by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ v. 9



This is our doctrine of justification by faith alone. When Christ's righteousness is credited to my account, I am declared just or righteous.






