




# Pleasing God as a Servant of Christ

# Galatians 1:9 (NET)

- As we have said before, and now I say again, if any one is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, let him be condemned to hell!



**Paul is NOT seeking the  
approval of God in a salvific way.**

**Paul has been saved by grace  
through faith in the Lord Jesus  
Christ (Eph. 2:8)**



# Paul is saved YET He still wants His

- **Preaching to please God**
- **Ministry to please God**
- **Life choices to please God**
- **Stewardship of the gospel to please God**
- **Work ethic to please God**
- **Personal holiness to please God**

**Ultimately Paul wants God to be pleased with  
Him. Do I?**



# Galatians 1:10

- For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God?



Is Paul teaching us  
not to care about  
the approval of  
man?



- Does the son seek the approval of his father?
- Does the paratrooper seek the approval of her squad leader?
- Does the soccer player seek the approval of his coach?
- Does the employee seek the approval of her employer?

If the answer is “no” then are they really seeking the approval of God.







# Hebrews 11:6

- And **without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.**




# Faith In:

- **God the Father**
  - > who created you and called you
- **God the Son**
  - > who died for your sins and rose again
- **God the Spirit**
  - > who seals, indwells, fill and desires to lead you

# Romans 8:8 (NET)

- **Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.** <sup>9</sup> You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, this person does not belong to him. <sup>10</sup> But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is your life because of righteousness.




# 1 Thessalonians 2:4

pleased.”**





- Jesus said to them, “**My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work.**




## John 6:38


# 1 John 3:22–23



- If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.




**Paul is a servant of

enlisted him.







## 2 Thessalonians 3:10 (NET)


- For even when we were with you, we used to give you this command: “If anyone is not willing to work, neither should he eat.”

- But **if someone does not provide for his own, especially his own family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.**


# Labor Participation Rate fell 5% in less than 20 years

- **Budgeting and careful spending**




