



Fellow Heirs with Jesus as Children of God

Galatians 4:1-7



I mean that **the heir**, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything,² but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father.³ In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world.⁴ But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might **receive adoption as sons**.⁶ And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, “Abba! Father!”⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then **an heir** through God.



Galatians 3:24

- So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.



Galatians 4:3

• In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world.



Both here and in v. 9 the expression refers to the elementary principles the Galatians previously followed, which for Jews would be the Mosaic law and for Gentiles the basic concepts of their pagan religions. But the additional overtones of demonic bondage in this phrase should not be ignored; they were, in terms of their mind-set and life situation, under a legalistic system and enslaved, and Paul explains in v. 8 that this enslavement was “to those that by nature are not gods.” Legalistic superstition and demonic domination are closely linked.



Paul is reminding each and everyone of us of our condition prior to being saved.

Blinded, enslaved, & dead

Completely alienated from God.



Since the physical reality is we are not blind, enslaved or dead it doesn't seem like a big deal to be redeemed, delivered or rescued.

We are spiritually blind, enslaved to sin, and dead to that which is divine.




Romans 5:8

we were still sinners, Christ died for us.



Acts 7:35

Notice Paul's point:

Born of a woman

How did Christ redeem us?



Galatians 3:13

- Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law
- by becoming a curse for us — for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged **on a tree**” —

- God creates the **tree of life** in the Garden of Eden (**Gen 2:9**)



- Man fell into sin at **a tree** (**Gen 3**)
- Christ hangs on a **tree** to redeem man from the fall (**Acts 5:30, 10:29, 13:39; Gal 3:13; 1 Pet 2:24**)
- Believers have been grafted in and share of the nourishing root of the **olive tree** (**Rom 11:17**)
- Those who conquer get to eat of the **tree of life** which is in the paradise of God (**Rev 2:7, 22:19**)



Revelation 22:19–21

•and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, **God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city**, which are described in this book.²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, “Surely I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.

- **adoption**




Turn to Ephesians

1:3-14



³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love ⁵ he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, ⁶ to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. ⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, ⁸ which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight ⁹ making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ ¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. ¹¹ In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, ¹² so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. ¹³ In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Once reason this may not sound like much of a big deal is because of the false teaching that everyone is a child of God.

Father!”



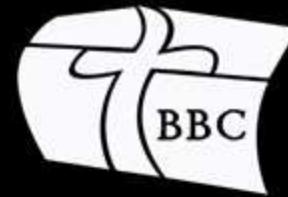
Turn to 1 John

1 John 3:1

- By this it is evident **who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil:** whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother.



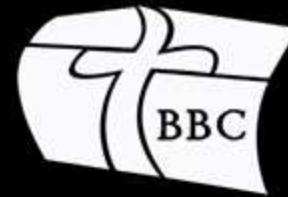

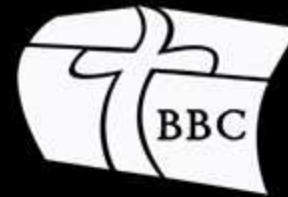
Matthew 19:29

- Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, **inherit the kingdom** prepared for you from the foundation of the world.





- And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.



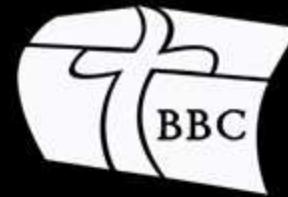
Romans 8:16–17


Ephesians 1:11, 14

- This mystery is that **the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.**




Ephesians 5:5

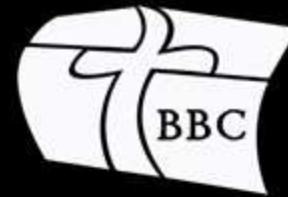
Colossians 3:24

•knowing that from the Lord you will **receive the inheritance as your reward.** You are serving the Lord Christ.



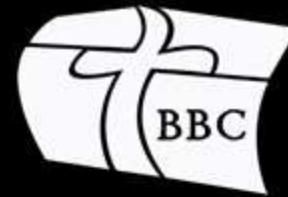
Hebrews 1:1–2

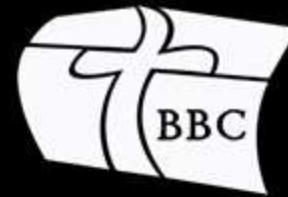
Hebrews 9:15

Hebrews 11:8


