Eat the Scroll

Revelation 10

1967 - 2017



Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven, wrapped in a cloud, with a rainbow over his head, and his face was like the sun, and his legs like pillars of fire. ² He had a little scroll open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the land, ³ and called out with a loud voice, like a lion roaring. When he called out, the seven thunders sounded. ⁴ And when the seven thunders had sounded, I was about to write, but I heard a voice from heaven saying, “Seal up what the seven thunders have said, and do not write it down.” ⁵ And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven ⁶ and swore by him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and what is in it, the earth and what is in it, and the sea and what is in it, that there would be no more delay, ⁷ but that in the days of the trumpet call to be sounded by the seventh angel, the mystery of God would be fulfilled, just as he announced to his servants the prophets. ⁸ Then the voice that I had heard from heaven spoke to me again, saying, “Go, take the scroll that is open in the hand of the angel who is standing on the sea and on the land.” ⁹ So I went to the angel and told him to give me the little scroll. And he said to me, “Take and eat it; it will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be sweet as honey.” ¹⁰ And I took the little scroll from the hand of the angel and ate it. It was sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it my stomach was made bitter. ¹¹ And I was told, “You must again prophesy about many peoples and nations and languages and kings.”


- Then I saw another mighty angel

This description assures us that this Angel came from God.


another mighty angel. Like God on his throne, he is surrounded by a rainbow (cf. 4:3). Like the Son of Man, he comes with a cloud, and his face shines like the sun (cf. 1:7, 16). His legs like pillars of fire reflect the glory of God's presence in the wilderness.

Revelation 1:1

•The revelation of Jesus Christ,
which God gave him to show to his
servants the things that must soon
take place. He made it known
by sending his angel to his
servant John,

Revelation 22:16



•“I, Jesus, have sent my
angel to testify to you about
these things for the churches. I
am the root and the descendant of
David, the bright morning star.”

Look @ v. 2

**This is the same scroll the angel had
in his hand in chapter 5 with 7 seals.**

**There is nothing to indicate this is the
book of Daniel.**



Revelation 10:2




•He had a little scroll open in his hand.

The scroll is open because the 7th seal has been broken.

The scroll is little because the angel is huge.

Revelation 10:2-3a

- And he set his right foot on the sea,
- and his left foot on the land,
- and called out with a loud voice, like a lion roaring.



The vision of an angel having one foot on the land and another foot on the sea roaring like a lion clearly establishes authority to communicate truth concerning judgment and the future.



Revelation 10:3b



- When he called out, the seven thunders sounded.


Seven thunders represent more judgment.

Revelation 10:5-6a

- And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven and swore by him who lives forever and ever,

**Raising the hand toward heaven
and swearing symbolically
authenticates the veracity of the
messenger and message.**

**Notice the angel swears by he
who created...**





Revelation 10:6

- **who created**
 - **heaven and what is in it,**
 - **the earth and what is in it,**
 - **and the sea and what is in it,**

**Not set in motion an
evolutionary process.**

This is the second reference to God creating.

The first was in Rev 4:11:

“Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.”

God as the Creator is what establishes his Sovereign power to direct all things to a predetermined end as He sees fit.

The mighty angel with the scroll swears by God

•that there would be no more delay,

Revelation 10:7



•but that in the days of
the trumpet call to
be sounded by the
seventh angel,

This promise of “no more delay” further emphasizes the reality that the 7th trumpet is the END.

The 7th trumpet is the same trumpet call described by Jesus and the Apostle Paul.



Matthew 24:31

- And he shall send his angels with a **great sound of a trumpet**, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

1 Corinthians 15:52

- In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound,** and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1 Thessalonians 4:16

- For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Revelation 10:7

•but that in the days of the trumpet call to be sounded by the seventh angel, **the mystery of God would be fulfilled, just as he announced to his servants the prophets.**

The Apostle Paul plainly
explains this mystery of
God in

Ephesians 1:9-10



Ephesians 1:9–10

- making known to us **the mystery of his will**, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ ¹⁰ **as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.**

The mystery of God is Christ. (Col 2:2).

The mystery is that God has a Son. (Matt 3)

The mystery is that God's Son would be Lamb of God.

The mystery is that God's Son would be the Messiah.

The mystery is that it has always been God's plan for the Son to be exalted. (Phil 2:9)

The mystery is that it has always been God's plan to unite Jews and Gentiles in Christ. (Eph 3:6)

The mystery is that it has always been God's plan to unite heaven and earth under the Lordship of Christ. (Eph 1.10)





Revelation 11:15

- Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever.”

Look at v. 8

John must “take the scroll” because there is much more to reveal concerning what will take place before the 7th trumpet.

I built a chart to show you all that is left to be told.

All of this is figuratively on the scroll.

Revelation 10:8

•Then the voice that I had heard from heaven spoke to me again, saying, “Go, take the scroll that is open in the hand of the angel who is standing on the sea and on the land.”

Revelation 10:9

- So I went to the angel and told him to give me the little scroll. And he said to me, “Take and eat it;

**John is not the first to
eat a scroll.**

Turn back to Ezekiel 3.



1 And he said to me, “Son of man, eat whatever you find here. Eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Israel.” **2** So I opened my mouth, and he gave me this scroll to eat. **3** And he said to me, “Son of man, feed your belly with this scroll that I give you and fill your stomach with it.” Then I ate it, and it was in my mouth as sweet as honey. **4** And he said to me, “Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak with my words to them.

•And I took the little scroll from the hand of the angel and ate it.

The Word of God
must be
internalized.

inform our decision making and direct
our paths.**

You have the words of eternal life,⁶⁹ and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God.”

People who believe this truth eat the Word of God up because they want to be in that United Kingdom under the Lordship of Christ.






Revelation 10:10

Revelation 17:6



- And I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints, the blood of the martyrs of Jesus.
- When I saw her, I marveled greatly.

Verse 11 reveals why John must eat the scroll—the story is not over—the Revelation of Jesus Christ is not complete.

Like Ezekiel he must prophesy.

There is more to be written.





Revelation 10:11

- **And I was told,**

**“You must again prophesy
about many peoples and
nations and languages and
kings.”**

John is not done; more must be written.

In case you are struggling with John prophesying again being a reference to finishing the book and the contents of the scroll being the continued revelation of how God unites the kingdom of heaven with kingdom of the earth.
