⁶ And he said to me, “These words are trustworthy and true. And the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants what must soon take place.” ⁷ “And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.” ⁸ I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me, ⁹ but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.” ¹⁷ The Spirit and the Bride say, “Come.” And let the one who hears say, “Come.” And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price. ¹⁸ I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book. ²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, “Surely I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! ²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.

True & Trustworthy

Except for: 1) the belief in the existence of God and 2) the bodily resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth **NOTHING** is more essential and fundamental to the Christian faith than the absolute confidence that the words in the Bible are “trustworthy and true”.



What do you believe about the words in this book?

19: 9	And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.”
21: 5	Also he said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.”
22: 6	And he said to me, “These words are trustworthy and true.”



Three Essential Questions

- 1) Is there a Creator God?**
- 2) Did the man Christ Jesus, God's Son, rise from the dead?**
- 3) Did the Holy Spirit of God inspire men to write words that are true and trustworthy and have they been preserved in the Bible?**

God sent Him an angel.



We believe

- 1. In a Supreme All Powerful Creator Triune God.**
- 2. This God has a legions of angels accomplishing His Will.**
- 3. Approximately 6000+ years ago one such angel, Satan, led an angelic rebellion against God which resulted in his fall and a host of other angels fall from God's grace.**
- 4. God created humans wholly and completely different from angels in His image and able to be redeemed from the fall.**

While we openly struggle with understanding the word “soon” that does not keep us from believing in the promise of a man who rose from the dead.

- to establish His eternal kingdom on a new earth.

This was not a human like figure.

John who saw the resurrected Jesus is moved to reverence and obeisance.

“the prophets” nearly always refers to the OT men of God who God used to speak to His people and proclaim truth.

Revelation 22:12

- “Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay each one for what he has done.

Simple and plain verses like this are why I can't subscribe to multiple resurrections and multiple judgments.

Recompense is a neutral word.

- **To those who followed Christ the recompense will be reward.**
- **To those who ignored Christ the recompense will be wrath.**

These 2 verses are sometimes used by the KJV-only segment of the body of Christ as an argument for the exclusivity of a single translation.

The problem with that argument is John didn't write these words in old English.

This stark warning should encourage us NOT to do 3 things:

Sensationalize

present information about something (the NT book Revelation) in a way that provokes public interest and excitement, at the expense of accuracy



Every effort must be made to avoid sensationalizing the book because it was written to the second century church under intense persecution in need of legitimate words of hope, encouragement, and application—NOT hype, speculation, and conjecture.

Outline of Biblical Usage [?]

- I. firm
 - A. metaph. faithful
- II. verily, amen
 - A. at the beginning of a discourse - surely, truly, of a truth
 - B. at the end - so it is, so be it, may it be fulfilled. It was a custom, which passed over from the synagogues to the Christian assemblies, that when he who had read or discoursed, had offered up solemn prayer to God, the others responded Amen, and thus made the substance of what was uttered their own.

The word "amen" is a most remarkable word. It was transliterated directly from the Hebrew into the Greek of the New Testament, then into Latin and into English and many other languages, so that it is practically a universal word. It has been called the best known word in human speech. The word is directly related — in fact, almost identical — to the Hebrew word for "believe" (amam), or faithful. Thus, it came to mean "sure" or "truly", an expression of absolute trust and confidence. — HMM
