Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. ³ Give us day by day our daily bread. ⁴ And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. ⁵ And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; ⁶ For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? ⁷ And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. ⁸ I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. ⁹ And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. ¹⁰ For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. ¹¹ If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? ¹² Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? ¹³ If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?



“Thy will be done” prayers include:

- Any request for wisdom
- Petitions for discernment
- Appeals for all forms of reconciliation
- Anything to do with sanctification
- Calls for repentance



Matthew 6:11

- Give us this day our daily bread.

Petition #3

Twenty-first century application of “give us this day our daily bread” must include:

- Acknowledgement that God is the ultimate source of substance
- Petitions for food
- Requests for work or employment
- Good health in order to work
- God’s blessing upon my work
- Safety and security so that I can work
- Wisdom to work well
- Petitions for good stewardship
- Divine intervention to overcome the effects of the fall



Matthew 6:12

- And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

Petition #4

Why are we asking God to forgive our sins if we are saved?

Saved people have been declared just or righteous. The debt of their sin has been cancelled according to Col. 2:14.



**I believe we repent and seek

and fellowship with our Creator
and His Son.**
- 3. Do not want our prayers
hindered.**

1 John 3:4

• Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

NET, ESV, NASB

• Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; indeed, sin is lawlessness.

The Greek word ἀνομία (anomia) is often translated “iniquity” or “lawlessness” and in the LXX refers particularly to transgression of the law of Moses. In Jewish thought the ideas of sin (ἀμαρτία, hamartia) and lawlessness or iniquity (ἀνομία) were often equated because sin involved a violation of the Mosaic law and hence lawlessness.



Christianity 101

**The law of Christ is
what we are under as
His disciples.**



The law of Christ is Christ's summary of what is the most important of the commandments from the law given by Moses to the people of God.

The law of Christ is found in Matthew 22:38-39, Mark 12:30-31, Luke 10:27, John 13:34, Romans 13:9, 1 Corinthians 9:21, Galatians 6:2, and in James 2:8 it is described as the royal law.





Mark 12:30-31

- **And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.** ³¹ **And the second *is* like, *namely* this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.**

Consider how JUST these two commandments impact our understanding of sin

- 1. We don't abort babies because a baby is the closest neighbor God will ever give a mom to love.**
- 2. The reason we aren't nasty to the cashier is because we would not want anyone being nasty to us if we were the cashier.**
- 3. Since gender is established by God and given to me from God I can't rebel against what He gave me and say I love Him with all my heart, mind and soul!**
- 4. Because the lifestyle of homosexuality doesn't produce more neighbors to love—that can't be my sexual orientation of choice.**






Romans 13:9






Proverbs 30:8-9 NET

As I studied this 5th petition I didn't understand why the conjunction 'but' was used instead of 'and'

In other words, why isn't it?

And lead us not into temptation

And deliver us from the evil one.



The KJV translates Strong's G235 in the following manner: but (573x), yea (15x), yet (11x), nevertheless (10x), howbeit (9x), nay (4x), therefore (3x), save (2x), *not translated* (2x), *miscellaneous* (8x).

 - A.* nevertheless, notwithstanding
 - B.* an objection
 - C.* an exception
 - D.* a restriction
 - E.* nay, rather, yea, moreover
 - F.* forms a transition to the cardinal matter



What is the cardinal matter?

The cardinal matter is the main, chief, or primary matter.

As in the 4 cardinal directions are N, E, W, & S.



Petition 5A

As you lead and guide my life Lord, protect me from places, scenarios, and situations where I will be tempted to sin.

Petition 5B

And even more so Lord rescue or deliver me from evil desires and the world of evil and even the Evil one himself.



Evil

1 a: morally reprehensible: sinful, wicked

Merriam-Webster



There is a difference between “but deliver me from evil” and “deliver me from the Evil one.”

Evil is NOT merely the absence of good; like cold is the absence of warmth.

Biblically evil has a source of origin and that source is a fallen angelic being.






Matthew 13:19 & 38

- The field is the world, and the good seed is the sons of the kingdom. The weeds are the sons of the evil one,


