

Present Joy

Future Joy

This joy will be uninterrupted and boundless in its application and experience for the believer



Present Peace


This peace is found in knowing God and what He has said and done and is primarily internal and relational

Future Peace

This peace culminates in an eternal kingdom completely uninterrupted by strife, war, pestilence, plague or Satan

female) trusts in God**




Whose mind is stayed on you



Revelation 2:10


Jesus said:

Future Peace




Isaiah 9:6


Isaiah 53:5

The Future Peace in the OT develops in the NT in multiple ways:

- 1) Peace from the entire Godhead**
- 2) Internal peace**
- 3) Relational peace both horizontal
and vertical**
- 4) Future eternal peace**

God of Peace


Rom 15:33	May the God of peace be with you all. Amen.

our lives.**







- **Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.**





•I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.”




Colossians 3:15

The implications of Romans 5:1 are clear:




Only those who have been justified (declared righteous)

By faith in the death, burial and resurrection of the man Christ Jesus


Have peace with God

For ALL others the wrath of God still abides on them (John 3:36).




Ephesians 2:15–16

- by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, **so making peace**, ¹⁶ and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility.




Colossians 1:20




Romans 12:18


