How can we who died to sin still live in it?<sup>3</sup> Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup> We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.



# Newness of Life This demands a change from the OLD way of life.

For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.

We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

## Look How Paul Previously Said It Galatians 2:20





• I have been crucified with Christ.

 It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

1)The reality that I, my flesh, (sinful nature) died with Christ in a way that I cannot understand when I was saved.

2)I must continually put my flesh to death!

• **f** then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.



### Paul leads with the reality that all believers have been spiritually raised with Christ. Prior to this believers were spiritually dead but now they have been raised. Therefore...

#### •When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.



<sup>17</sup> For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. <sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, <sup>21</sup> envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. 
