Dear Potential Church Member,

In the same way that you are asking questions and trying to decide if you will unite in membership with Berean, Berean must also ask some questions of the person who wants to unite with us in membership.

The way Berean chooses to ask the important questions about the person wanting to become an active voting member of the congregation is to provide each applicant with a simple questionnaire. The questionnaire and accompanying testimony sheet will be reviewed by a pastor and, if necessary, other pastors when there is a question as to whether a person will be recommended to the church for membership. Ultimately, the voting membership must decide whether a person will be welcomed into the congregation (voting membership); however, God has ordained that pastors protect the flock from those whom they believe to be potentially harmful.

The purpose of the questionnaire is <u>not</u> to keep people from attending the church, but it does have the purpose of limiting who becomes a part of the adult voting membership and who serves in positions of childcare, leadership, and authority.

The church is full of sinners and we must guard against a spirit of self-righteousness; however, there is a distinct difference between someone involved in a lifestyle of sin and a person who is seeking to obey God's law by the grace of God. Attenders are welcomed and cared for by the entire church; however, there is a difference between an attender and a member. The primary difference is a member can serve in a multitude of positions of influence whereas the attender's influence is limited and not officially sanctioned by the church.

The membership questionnaire on the next page is designed to facilitate the membership interview with a pastor in protecting the flock of God from those whom they believe to be potentially harmful.

If you are trying to decide if you would be welcomed into the membership, the answer is "yes"—provided you are seeking to live with Jesus as your Lord and the Bible as your life's guide. The membership prohibitions on the third page are designed to succinctly communicate to those who would need to turn from particular issues before becoming a member. The entire church is committed to loving those who Christ loves and helping them, by God's grace, turn from anything that is a reproach to the cause of Christ.

Church Membership Prohibitions

A person cannot become a member of Berean Baptist Church if he or she is—

- Not a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ the Son of God
- Not willing to publicly profess their faith in Jesus as the Christ during everyday living
- Not willing to be baptized by immersion after faith in Jesus Christ
- Unwilling to live by the church covenant and Articles of Faith
- A homosexual or lesbian
- A member of a racial hate group such as the KKK, skin heads, Neo Nazis or any such group
- An unrepentant child molester
- A member of a secret society such as a Masonic Lodge
- An illegal alien
- Not willing to abandon an allegiance to Roman Catholicism
- Living with another person as husband or wife without being married
- Married and has more than one wife or husband
- Also a Muslim, Buddhist, Hindu or member of another world religion
- Also a Jehovah Witness, Mormon or member of a similar cult
- Unwilling to be faithful in their attendance to church services
- A business owner or employed at a place that would clearly and obviously be in conflict with the Church Covenant, Articles of Faith and values of this church and bring discredit to Christ and His Church such as a strip parlor, triple X movie theater or other such similar places
- Still involved with unresolved issues with his or her former church
- Engaged in adulterous or Biblically unlawful sexual relationships
- Unwilling to help support the financial needs of the church
