I know that I have placed this verse at the head of one of my previous letters, however, it seems even more fitting as I realize that it has been a while since my last update. Please forgive the delay! These are busy days where some things slip through the cracks. Again, I apologize for allowing these updates to be one of those things. Here is what has been happening since our last letter.

On The Road: In the last several months we have made two trips to Romania and Hungary for the purpose of continuing our Roma Institute ministry. We have begun a new session of classes in the town of Stei, Romania. Last May we completed several years of teaching ending with a Bachelor's Degree for the students. We now have a new class of students undergoing the teaching.

We also are continuing the lessons with the men of Gepiu and Tinca. The churches in Gepiu and Tinca share the hosting of these classes. I am grateful to both Pastor Ghitsa and Pastor Mirci as they encourage their men to be involved in learning the Bible and the various aspects of the ministry.

Also on these two trips we were able to spend time with the church plants that we have been involved with over the years. What a delight it is to encourage Pastor Silviu and Pastor Iosif as they continue the work of the ministry. In February, I was allowed by God to spend several days with pastor Iosif Teglas in three of his ministries. What a faithful man of God!

In these past several months we have also increased our presence in India. Last year we held monthly, five hours seminars with Brother Maloth Ravinder, teaching 28 Indian Gypsy preachers. This year we are teaching two monthly, five hour seminars with a total of 56 Indian Gypsy preachers. These seminars are taught via the internet in two different villages. It is thrilling to see the men gathered in a church building anxious to learn the Word of God and practical ministry principles.

There has also, in these last several months, been opportunities to present missions and ROMA in several churches in West Virginia, Florida, Georgia and Louisiana.

On the Home Front: We have upgraded our flooring to rid ourselves of dust collecting carpeting. This will help us with allergy problems. Continue to pray for Eileen as she has several health issues that cause us some concerns.

In the Works: The rest of this year and the coming year see the advancement of some projects. There is a plan to visit our ministries in India during the month of November. Please pray for this trip and the finances for travel expenses. In January 2025, there is a planned trip to Peru for ROMA missionary training and Bible Conference.

From Our Hearts: We continue to be extremely grateful for your faithful prayer and financial support! Our ministries could not continue without your understanding and faithful support. God's blessings to all of you as we begin a new year of service!!
