The Lord is blessing our efforts. We are seeing Ukrainians come to know the Lord as their SAVIOR! Rejoice with us in the repentance of Nikolas and Viktoria! This couple has been attending the Raleigh Bible Study for about 6 months. They lived together and only came to Bible Study for fellowship. God's Word convicted their hearts - they recently repented and then asked Oleg to marry them. It was our joy to see God's Word, and the many-fold witness of church members bring about an understanding of sin, the need for forgiveness, and making things right. Praise the Lord! They were married on Friday! This couple has expressed a desire to take the next step of obedience to the Lord and be baptized.

The Raleigh church is doing well. We have newcomers just about every week. Many are unbelievers who are coming for fellowship and have never been to an Evangelical, non-Orthodox church service. We make sure to get their contact information, and many of them come back to the Bible Study. They are not yet ready to jump from what they know as "church" to a traditional, Baptist-non-Orthodox church setting. Pray for us as we reach out to the Raleigh, NC, Ukrainian refugee community. The changes to federal immigration policies have affected the refugee program through which many Ukrainians are in our area. They have a sense of panic and uncertainty, even though they are here legally and have all the needed documents. Please pray for us as we help comfort, advise, and direct people's minds to the ONE who can offer peace and wisdom to navigate uncertainty. Attached to this email are pictures of several of the families who need your prayers for peace and wisdom. We will ask for prayer for different families in our ministry in our future updates.

The Miami church plant is growing! Brother Ihor has been taken on for support by two other Ukrainian churches!!!! He now receives enough support to cover his rent and can focus more of his attention on evangelism and discipleship. This is a huge praise and answer to prayer. Please pray that Ihor's family will get permission to come to the United States. Their documents were delayed, and his family's status is uncertain now that the U4U government program has been frozen. Ihor's faith is strong. He sees God blessing and knows that there is a legal path for his family to join him. Please pray for our family as we help in this process.

Please pray for Oleg to have wisdom as he looks for Ukrainian pastors/missionaries to start churches here in the United States where there is no

Gospel witness in Ukrainian. There is an open door in the Ukrainian refugee community for the Gospel. We feel an urgency to "redeem the time" for Kingdom purposes.

Ukraine is losing ground to ruzzia in the Eastern regions. Random, chaotic missile strikes routinely terrorize civilians. People are discouraged and scared and often turn to substances for comfort. Our dedicated team of Ukrainian brothers and sisters has been so faithful in encouraging frontline civilians and soldiers with God's Word and humanitarian aid. Their regular trips into these regions are a light in the darkness of war. Please pray for Kostya, Katya, Tanya, Kevin, Sergei, Slavik, and Irina. Pray for physical and spiritual protection for these brave brothers and sisters in Christ. They work closely with churches that have remained open in these regions. They evangelize the lost and encourage ministers living in war zones.

The feeding ministries to orphans in Odesa and war refugee children in Kyiv continue to grow. Thank you for your prayers and financial support to these vital community outreaches. Children receive a warm meal, a Bible lesson, and fun games when they come to the feeding centers. Children in Christian Family Homes are being raised by believers dedicated to caring for orphans in their time of need. We get requests for help from other similar ministries almost daily. Our hearts are extremely burdened for these young Ukrainians who have seen so much violence and despair. **Please cover this vital ministry in prayer!**

We look forward to hearing from you! We would love to hear how the Lord is working in your lives and ministries. This would be a tremendous encouragement to us.
