This is our fifth year meeting at the Hilton Back Bay hotel as a church. As God has brought more growth to the church, we have had to make some adjustments over the years—requeusting more chairs, rearranging the room, and adding an additional service time. Our average attendance since September is about 200 people across both services! Even with the anticipation of sending out a team to plant a church in South Boston this upcoming fall, we have been feeling the limitations of our meeting space. Thanks to our good working relationship with the Hilton, we have moved to a larger ballroom for a minor price increase! This larger space will not only better accommodate our current needs, but it will also provide room for more growth.

In the Lord's timing and providence, we got to move to this new space a couple weeks before Easter, which will be incredibly helpful as this is a Sunday when we see a ton of new guests. **Please continue to pray for God's provision for our church, for continued growth, and especially for the gospel opportunities that Easter brings.**

As I have often mentioned in these letters, your prayerful support is our biggest ask. **Please continue to pray that God would provide for my salary.** We are blessed that Katie will have the opportunity to start working part time starting this coming fall, but this does come with a significant cut in pay for her. We are confident that God will continue to make good on the promise to care for us day-by-day. Here is an update on some numbers so that we can praise God together for how He is providing and pray that He will continue to do so. By God's grace and through the generosity of many, we have come closer to my monthly support goal. Below is a breakdown of the \$1,550 in monthly support I still need to raise:

- 1 donor giving \$100 a month
- 5 donors giving \$75 a month
- 10 donors giving \$50 a month
- 13 donors giving \$25 a month
- 25 donors giving \$10 a month
