

Good afternoon,

I hope this message finds you well. As the summer comes to close, there are many things we are thanking God for here in Boston. Most notably, our church recently celebrated two more baptisms. One, an Irish woman named Sorcha – God used her recently converted brother and other believers to share the gospel with her and encourage her to plug into a church. The other, a Turkish man named Arif – he started coming to King's Hill Church after having dreams about Jesus. He grew up in a Muslim family but after moving away, would describe himself as an atheist. After coming to church and hearing the gospel, Arif put his faith in Christ, and within just a few months, has read almost the entirety of the Bible. Both Sorcha and Arif are great reminders of God bringing the nations to Boston, and more importantly, to Himself. Please pray for both of them as they grow in their faith, and especially for Arif's relationship with his family back in Turkey. We recently heard that his family has completely disowned him after hearing of his conversion.



Every summer, in partnership with the North American Mission Board, King's Hill and other churches around the city receive interns who serve for June and July. I

had the privilege of leading 15 of these interns through the GenSend Worship Leader Cohort, which I helped start a few years ago. This Cohort is open to any of the summer interns throughout the city who are interested in developing music leadership skills and learning more about the theology of worship. They go through some online content on their own, then come together to discuss as a group with me and to get to hear from a variety of worship leaders throughout the city. Additionally, many of them helped lead and play instruments for various worship services during their two months here. *There are still many neighborhoods of Boston that need gospel-believing churches.* The hope of this program is to help encourage and raise up music leaders who are ready and willing to be a part of the many churches we hope to see planted over the coming years in and around the city. **Please pray for God to stir in the lives of many to see more churches planted in the city of Boston.**



In a couple of days on September 1, over 70% of people in Boston will be moving apartments. This provides us with an amazing opportunity to reach the city through our largest outreach event of the year – The Big Move. There are hundreds of volunteers from partner churches and from within King's Hill who will be extending help to people carrying boxes, moving furniture, and getting settled into their new homes. This provides numerous opportunities to share the gospel, pray with people, and invite them to church and other church events as the fall gets kicked off. Please pray for God to miraculously use this time to bring unbelievers to saving faith.
