

Good afternoon,

Thank you so much for your prayers for the Big Move. This day spent helping our neighbors move was a massive success. Every year, as we've had more volunteers come up to help out, we have been able to reach and help more people throughout Boston. Last year, we had 170 volunteers travel to Boston for the Big Move. This year, we had 280 volunteers in the city (not including all of those from King's Hill who were also serving). We were able to connect with hundreds of people as we helped them move, pray with them, share the gospel, and invite them to church.

Someone from the Huntington News (a local news publication at Northeastern University) took note of our presence this year and wrote an article about the ways we were serving our city. You can read the article here.



The days following the Big Move, many from King's Hill spread around the city at various train stations and other popular spots to hand out free granola bars with church invitations. Thanks to the efforts of our people taking off work or volunteering their free time, we were able to pass out roughly 14,000 church invitations.

Through the Big Move and the invitational efforts that followed, we have seen many people visit King's Hill over the past month. Some of these visitors were a group of young men who decided to show up to a worship night we hosted. They described themselves as "spiritually seeking" and have been attending church and exploring the Bible. Please be praying for these young men and the many people we connected with during the Big Move and the weeks that have followed.



Last month, in partnership with the Baptist Churches of New England and the North American Mission Board, I helped start a monthly worship gathering for college students around the city of Boston. The hope of this gathering is to provide a space for Christians around the city to hear about what God is doing in and through other churches and to spur them on to missional living while in college and as they make plans for their future. Please pray for God to use these efforts to encourage more Christians in our city to prioritize the gospel in their lives.



As the fall is in full swing, here are some more ways you can be praying for us and for King's Hill Church:

- We will soon be hosting fall mission teams. <u>Please pray for God to work</u> through those who will be visiting Boston on these short term trips, much like the trips Katie and I took years ago before moving to Boston.
- Katie and I have continued hosting a Life Group in our home. We are
 blessed to have a small group of married couples in our home every week
 to study the Word and pray together. Pray for these relationships to be
 continually encouraging and strengthening as brothers and sisters in Christ.
- Pray for continued provision from the Lord. We have seen God provide through His people in so many different ways over the past few years, and we are beyond grateful for the prayers, support, and financial provision. As I shared in the previous newsletter, I am still working towards my monthly support goal, please pray for God to provide for our needs.
