# 5Ws1H

**Why: Seven Reasons**

**How: By Crucifixion**

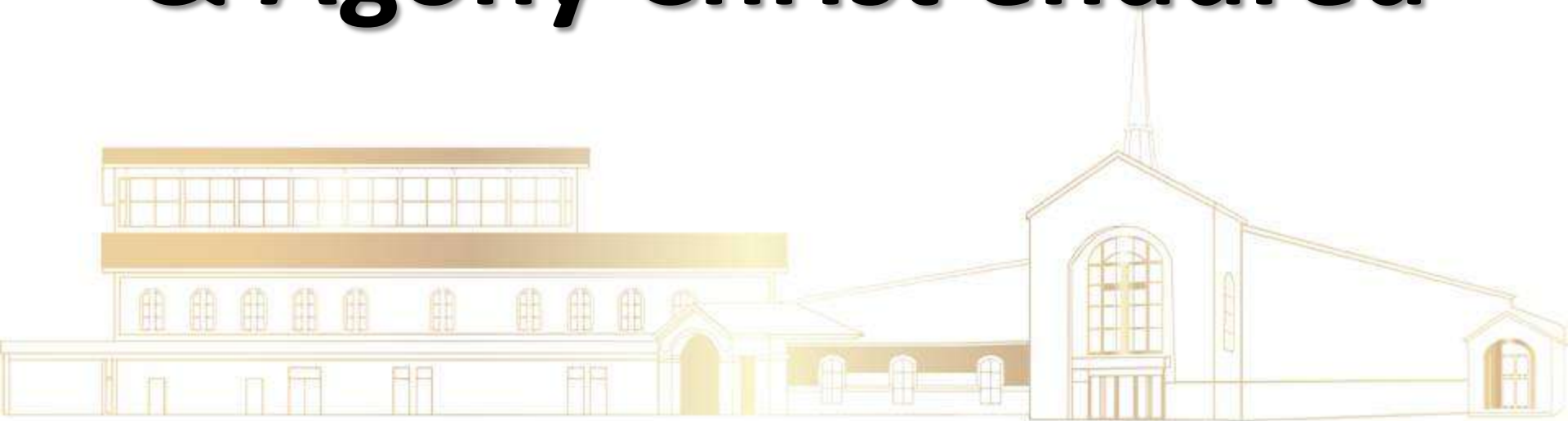
Crucifixion is a method of capital punishment in which the victim is tied, nailed, or otherwise attached to a large wooden beam and left to hang for several days until eventual death from exhaustion and asphyxiation.

- and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.



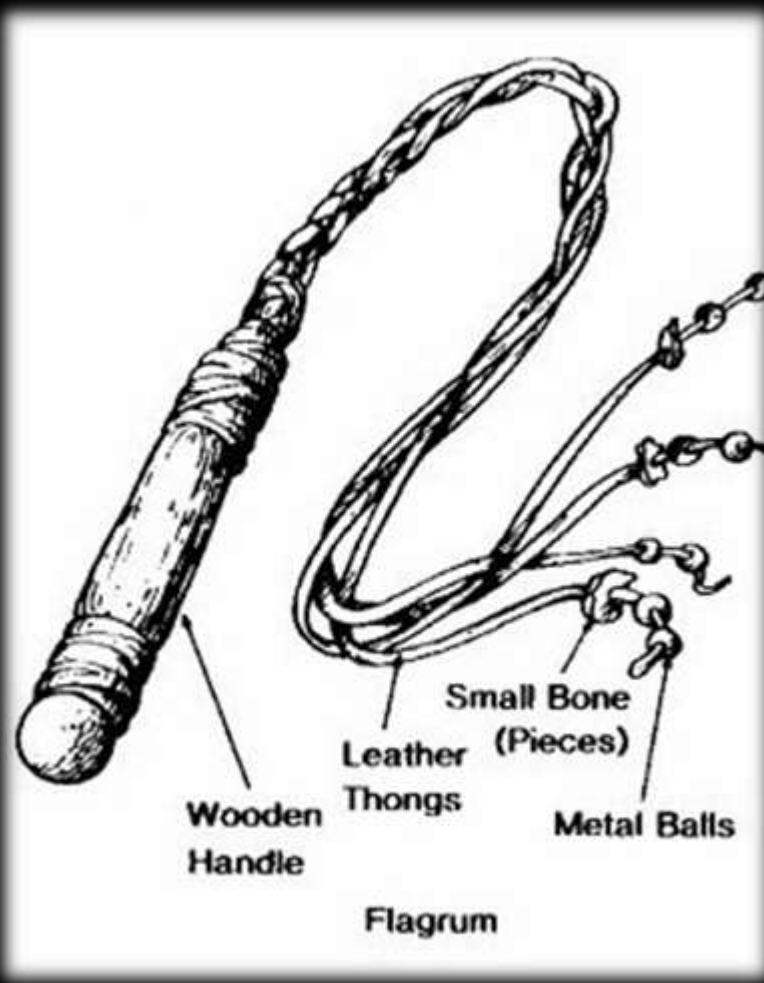


# Matthew 26:67-68 (ESV)

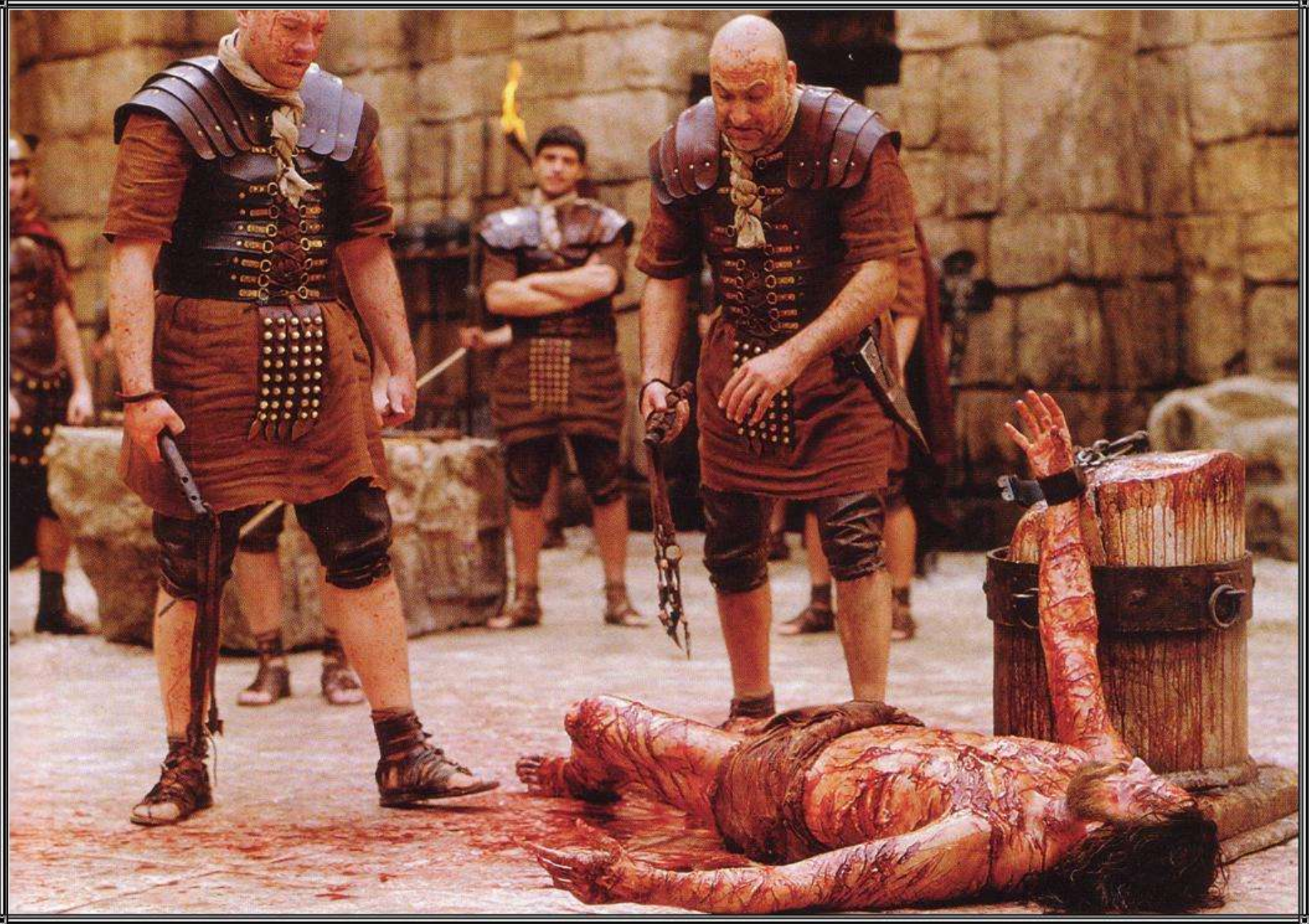
- Then they spit in his face and struck him.
- And some slapped him, <sup>68</sup> saying, “Prophecy to us, you Christ! Who is it that struck you?”

# Matthew 27:26 (ESV)

- Then he released for them Barabbas, and having scourged Jesus, delivered him to be crucified.









## Isaiah 53:5 (NASB)

- But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.

# Matthew 27:27-31

- Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the governor's headquarters, and they gathered the whole battalion before him. <sup>28</sup> And they stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, <sup>29</sup> and twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on his head and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" <sup>30</sup> And they spit on him and took the reed and struck him on the head. <sup>31</sup> And when they had mocked him, they stripped him of the robe and put his own clothes on him and led him away to crucify him.



# John 19:17

- And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called *the place* of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha:

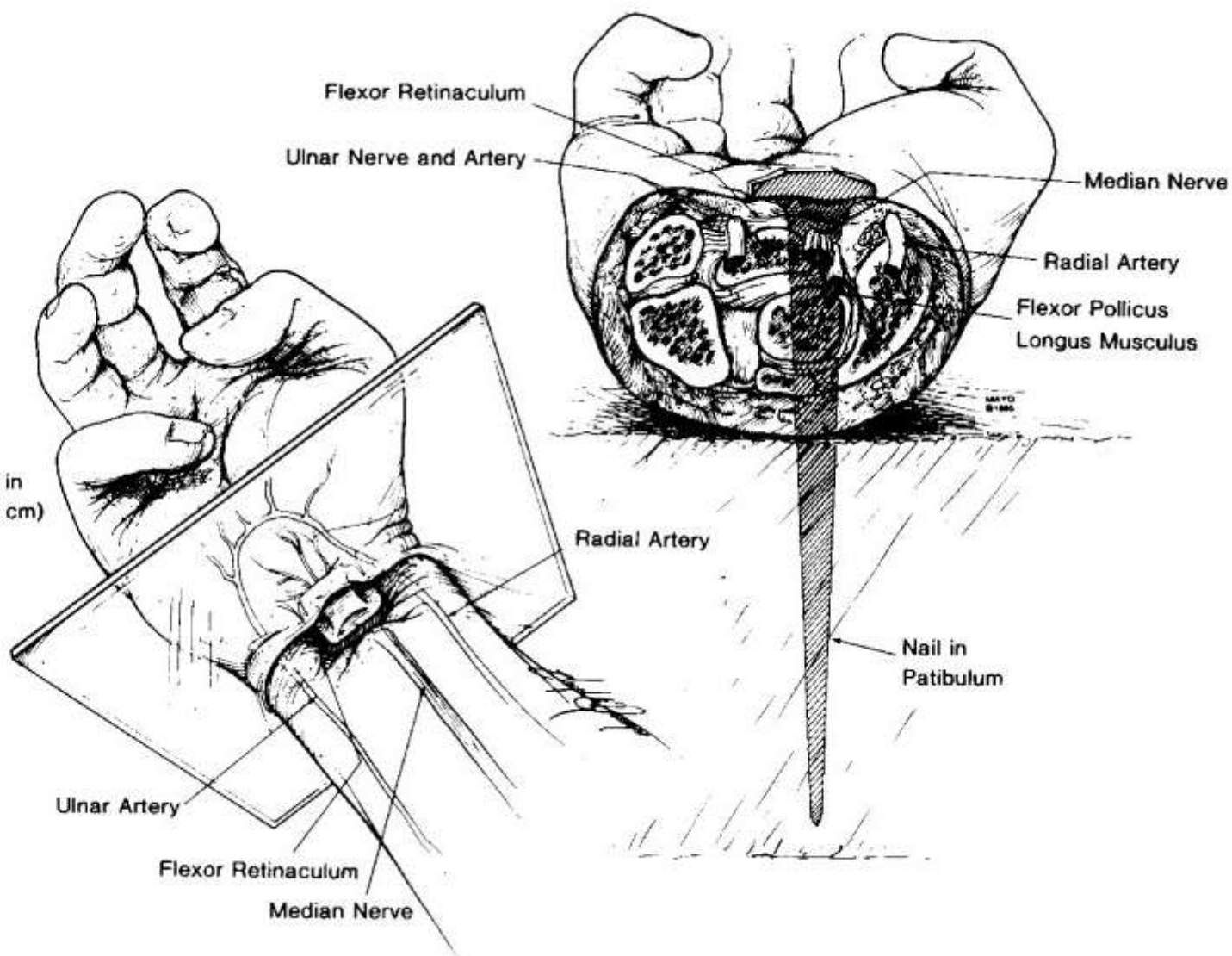






# John 20:25

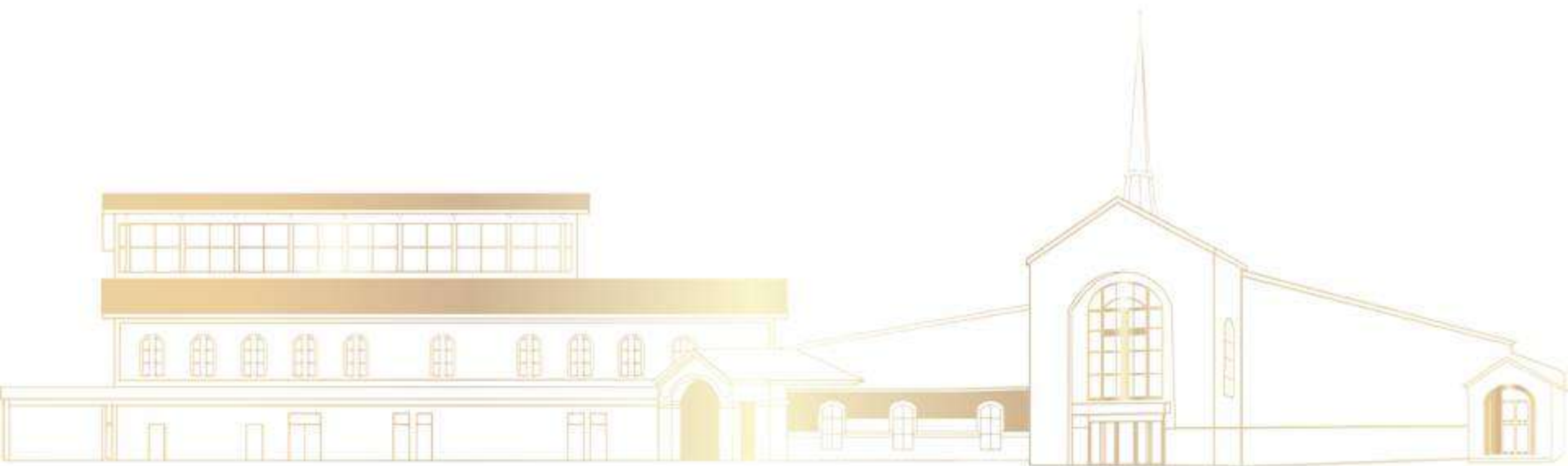

- But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.



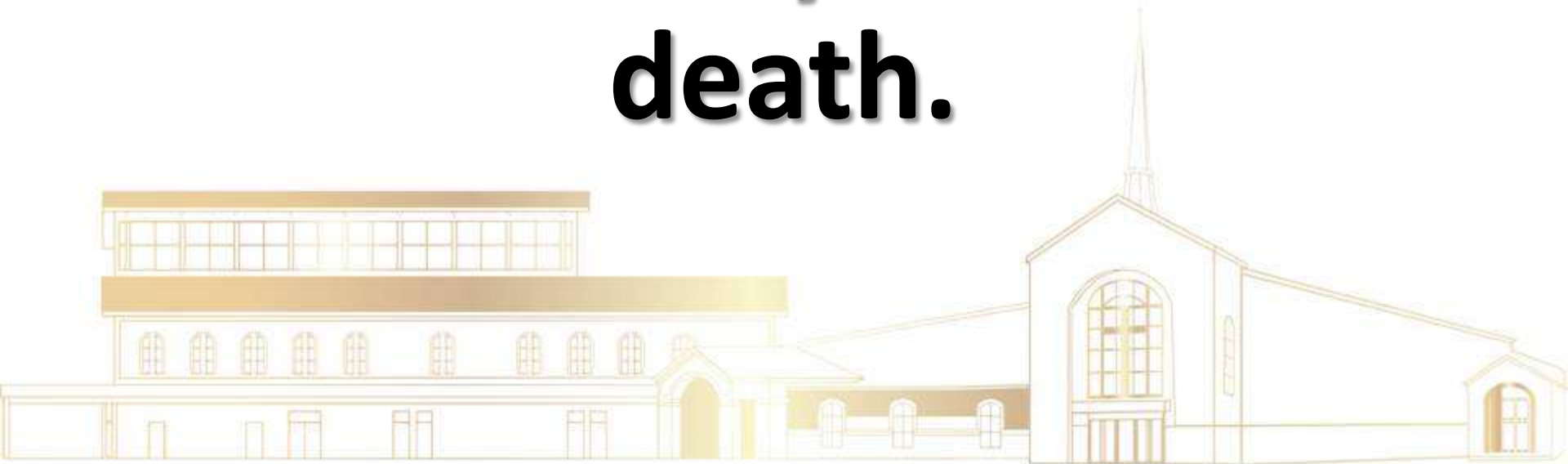
# Ephesians 5:25

# Ephesian 1:7 (ESV)

- In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace,



# Galatians 3:13; 4:5

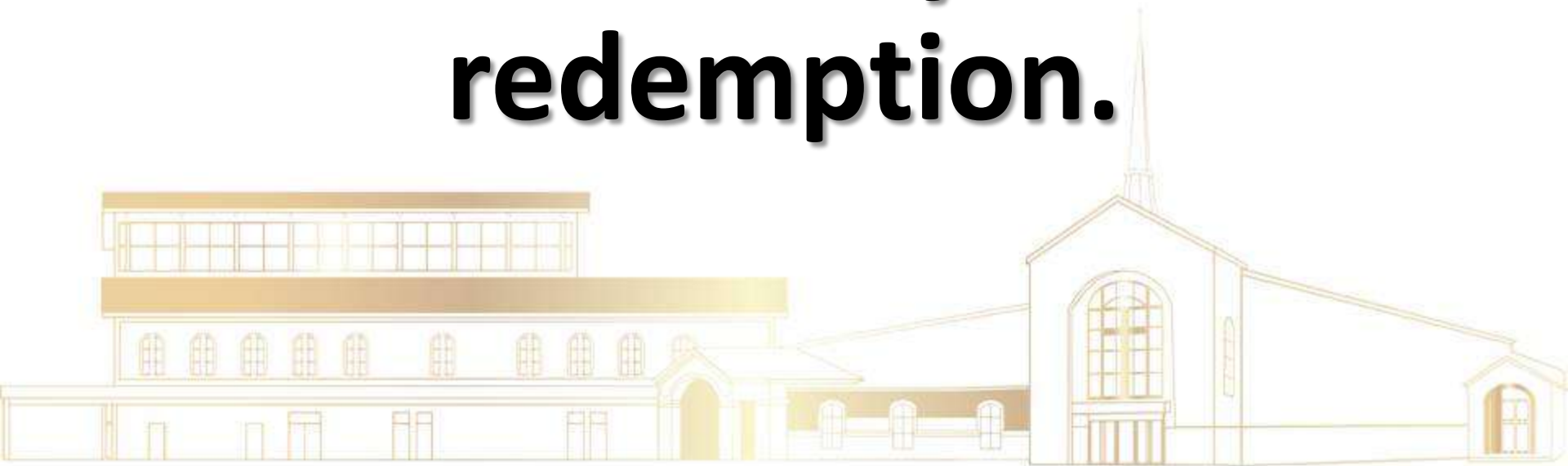
- Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree”—
- to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.



# John 1:29

- The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!”

**#3 On the cross Christ  
paid (ransom) all that  
was necessary for our  
redemption.**

- just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

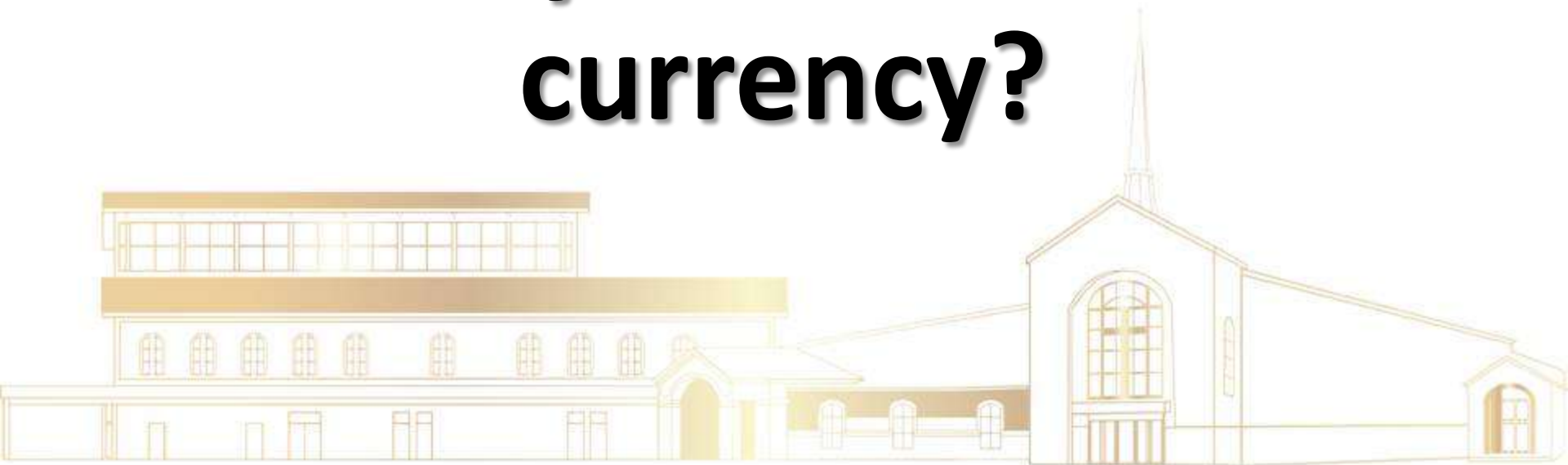


# 1 Timothy 2:6

- who gave himself as  
a ransom for all,  
revealing God's purpose at his  
appointed time.

# Acts 20:28

- Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

**#4 Christ took our place  
(replacement) and  
suffered and died for  
our sins on that cross.**





# Hebrews 2:9 (AV)

- But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.



# 1 John 2:2

- And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for *the sins of the whole world*.
- and he himself is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for our sins but also for the whole world.

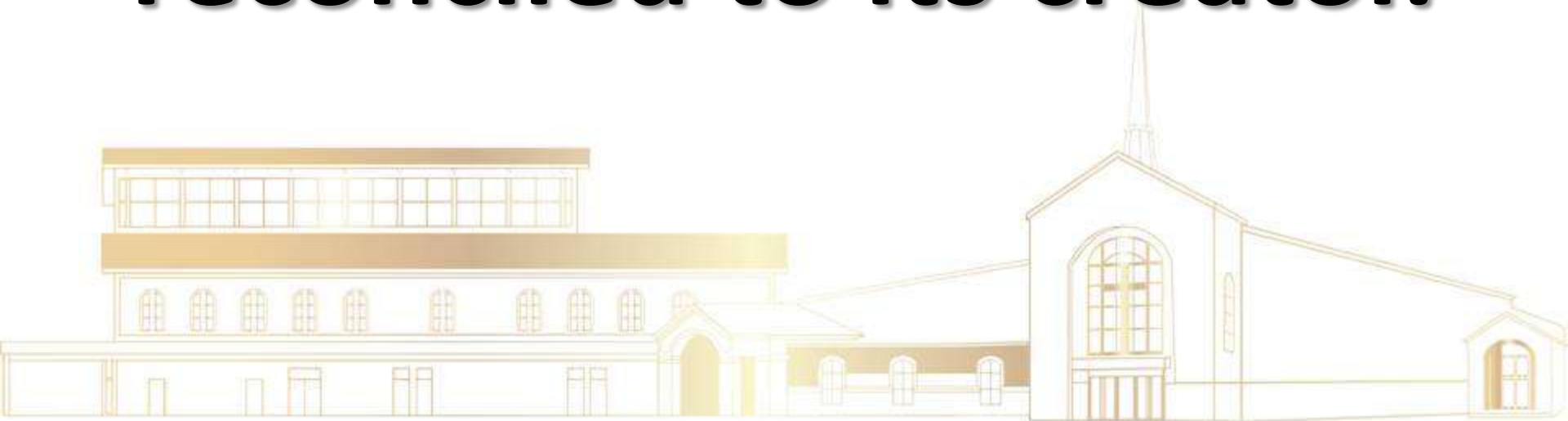


# 1 Peter 2:24

- He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

# Colossians 1:20 (AV)

- And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, *I say*, whether *they be* things in earth, or things in heaven.

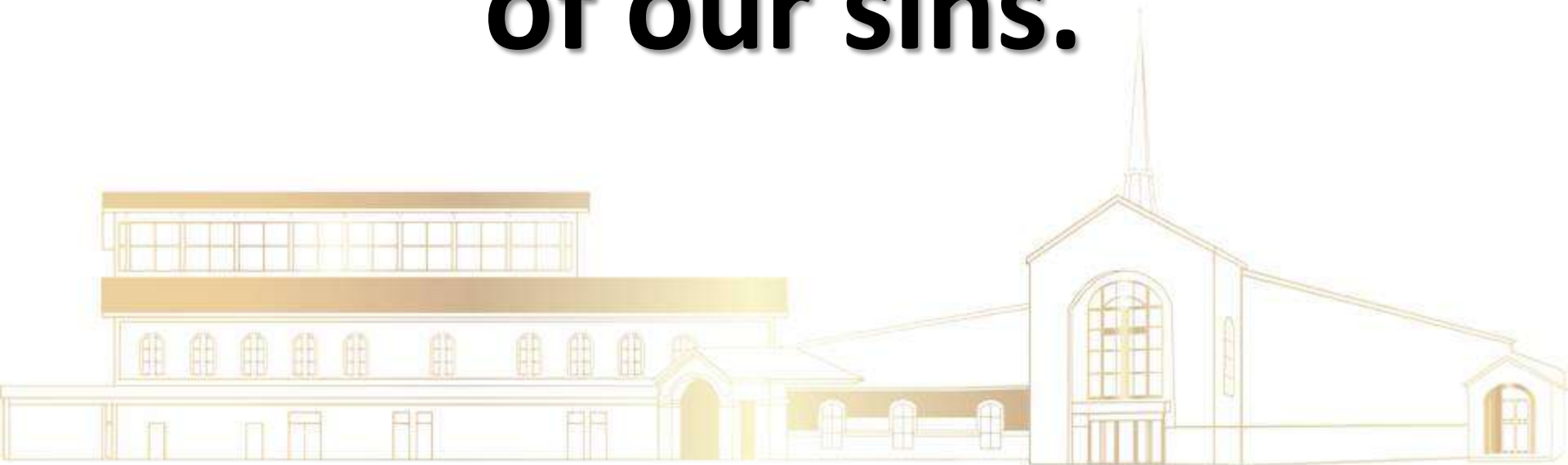


## 2 Corinthians 5:19 (NET)

- In other words, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting people's trespasses against them, and he has given us the message of reconciliation.

exacting or inflicting  
(a debt or punishment)





# Colossians 2:14

- **by** canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands.
- **This he set aside,** nailing it to the cross.





# Hebrews 9:22 (ESV)

- Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no [remission] forgiveness of sins.
