


Philippians 2:9-11

 Therefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.



The exaltation of Christ is contrasted with the humiliation of Christ.








To Exalt

17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, 18 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church,


Exalted to sit on the Father's right hand.

 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.



- Secured the eternal redemption of all who previously believed and all who would believe the gospel



John 3:18

He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.



John 20:31

But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.


Bowing the knee physically communicates a recognition of the authority of the person to whom one is bowing.

Bowing the knee is an act of submission.





His Name

- Jesus given by Mary
 - Hebrew origin Joshua
 - Save his people from their sins
- Christ is Christos = Anoint
 - He is the Messiah of Daniel 9:25ff
- Lord is English for Kyrios
 - Sovereign Master

Being made Lord is the coronation of the exaltation.




Romans 14:9
