⁷ “And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: ‘The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens. ⁸ “ ‘I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut. I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. ⁹ Behold, I will make those of the synagogue of Satan who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie—behold, I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you. ¹⁰ Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth. ¹¹ I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown. ¹² The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God. Never shall he go out of it, and I will write on him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down from my God out of heaven,
and my own new name.

Revelation 3:7

**who has the key of David,

**“Key of David” is one of 1000s of
connection points back to the OT**

From Isaiah 22:22 the “key of David” symbolically represents Christ’s Sovereign power to grant or exclude entrance into the eternal kingdom of God to whomever He chooses.

He alone NOW has “the key of David.”

Isaiah 22:20–22

**In that day I will call my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah,
21 and I will clothe him with your robe, and will bind your sash on him, and will commit your authority to his hand. And he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. 22 And I will place on his shoulder the key of the house of David. He shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.**

Matthew 16:17–19 (ESV)

And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. ¹⁸ And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.”





Revelation 3:8

**this exact sentence is used
5x in 7 letters**

Ephesians 2:8-10

- For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus for good works**, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

What does the open door represent?

Revelation 4:1

- After this I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven! And the first voice, which I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet, said, “Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.”

The “open door” is the entrance into the eternal kingdom of God.

We know this because of the reference to the key which locks and unlocks the door.

And the context of the letter; every other promise in the letter deals w/ things in heaven. See vs. 12.

The fact is:



Revelation 3:10

- Because you have kept my word about patient endurance,

What does
this mean?

AV—the word of patience

NKJV—My command to persevere

NASB—My perseverance

NET—my admonition to endure steadfastly

ESV—my word about patient endurance

CSB—my command to endure



Although NOT readily seen in the four gospels according to Revelation 3:10 Jesus has commanded His followers to hold fast to the faith or to persevere until the end.

Notice He says, because you have kept my command to persevere...

Revelation 3:10

- Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth.

What is the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world?

Is it a particular period of global tribulation?

If the answer is yes only the church at Philadelphia is promised to be protected from the hour of trial?



Those who hold to pre-tribulation rapture of the church use this text as proof that it is Christ's intent to protect all churches from the tribulation by means of the rapture.

This is a difficult interpretation to endorse because of the words “Because you have...”

Because you have seems very conditional.



Finally, the text does NOT say the church at Philadelphia is being raptured or removed.

KJV Translation Count — Total: 75x

The KJV translates Strong's G5083 in the following manner: keep (57x), reserve (8x), observe (4x), watch (2x), preserve (2x), keeper (1x), hold fast (1x).
