**Philippians**

**1:21**



- 1) To live is Christ begins with the reality that Jesus is your Savior.
- 2) To live is Christ necessitates that Christ is your Lord—he is your Master.
- 3) To live is Christ manifests itself in following Christ's example.
- 4) To live is Christ requires that you know Christ.
- 5) To live is Christ is to live to serve others.
- 6) To live is Christ requires that we keep our focus on Jesus.
- 7) To live is Christ means that His Gospel is the single most important truth in your life.



8) To live is Christ focuses on applying the gospel to every area of our lives.

9) To live is Christ means that what he commanded are the commandments that we strive to live by every day.

10) To live is Christ demands that you make His Church—an absolute priority in your life.

11) To live is Christ requires you to love your spouse as Christ loved the church.

12) To live is Christ necessitates that you care about the world that God loved.



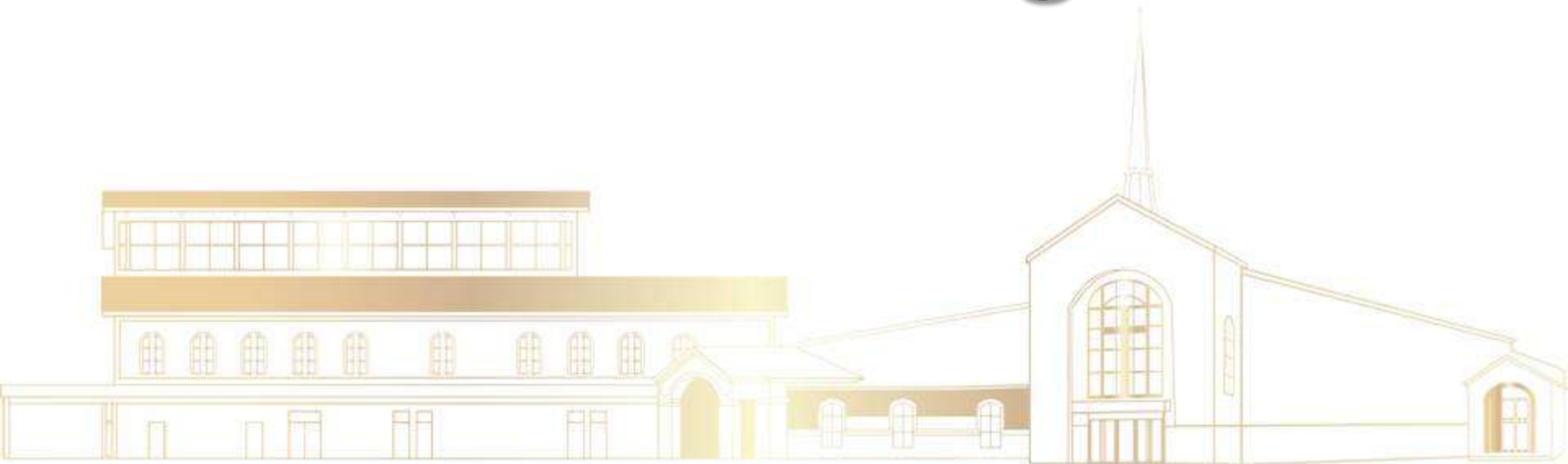

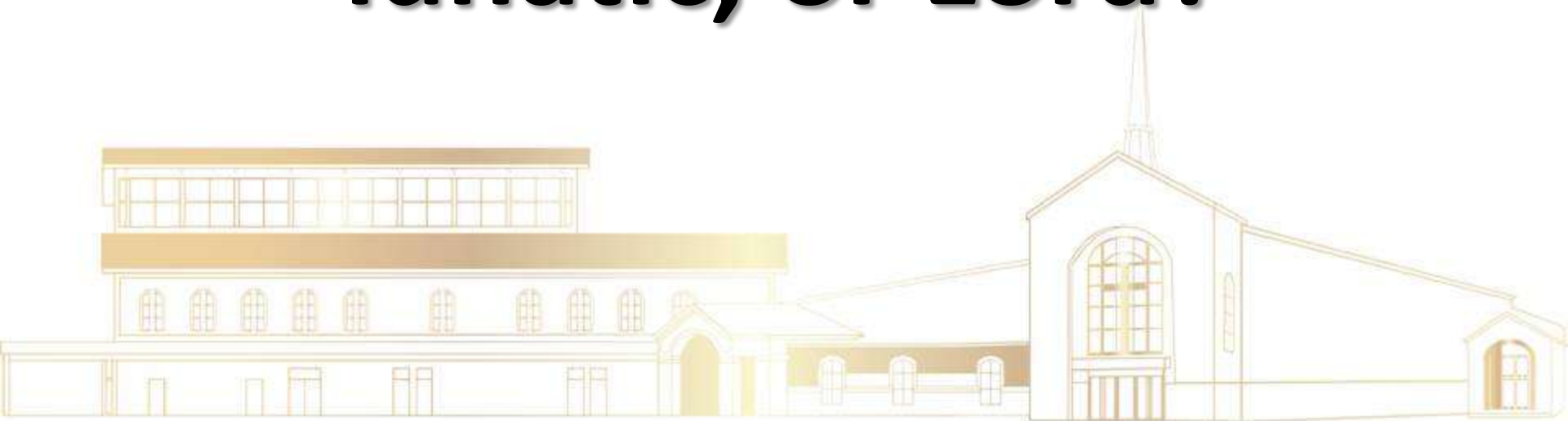

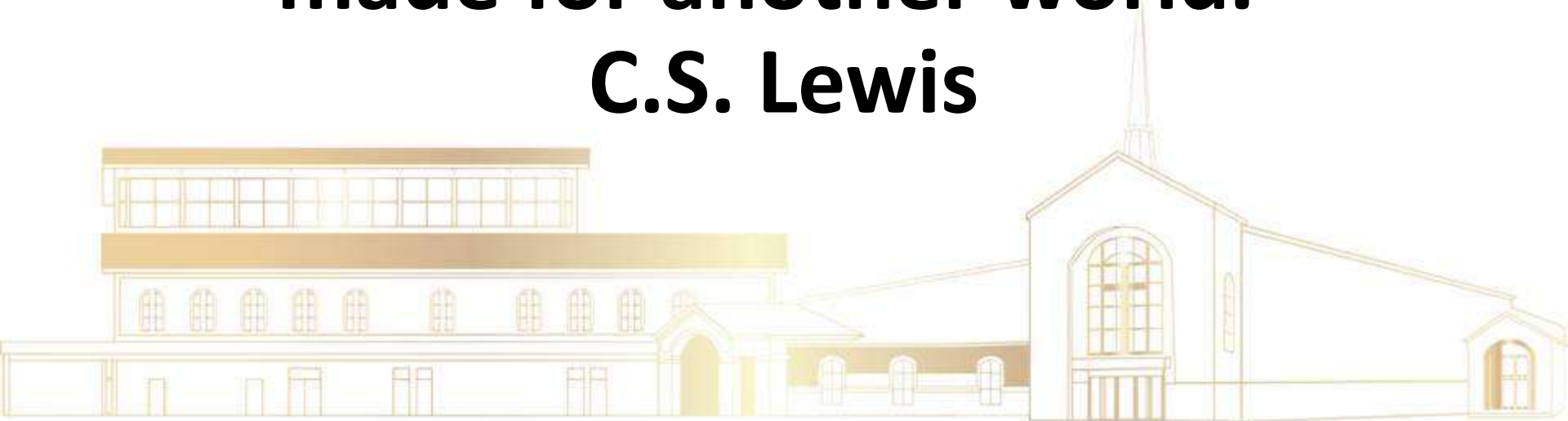
# Mark 10:29-30 (ESV)

# Revelation 21:15-16 (NET)

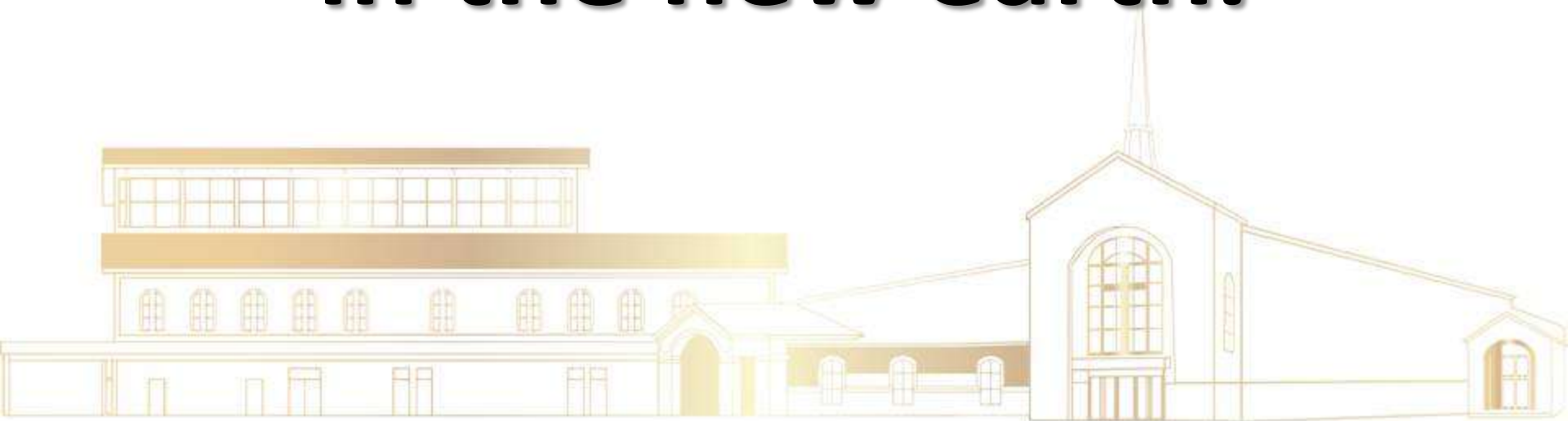

- No fights, arguments, etc.
- No drunkenness

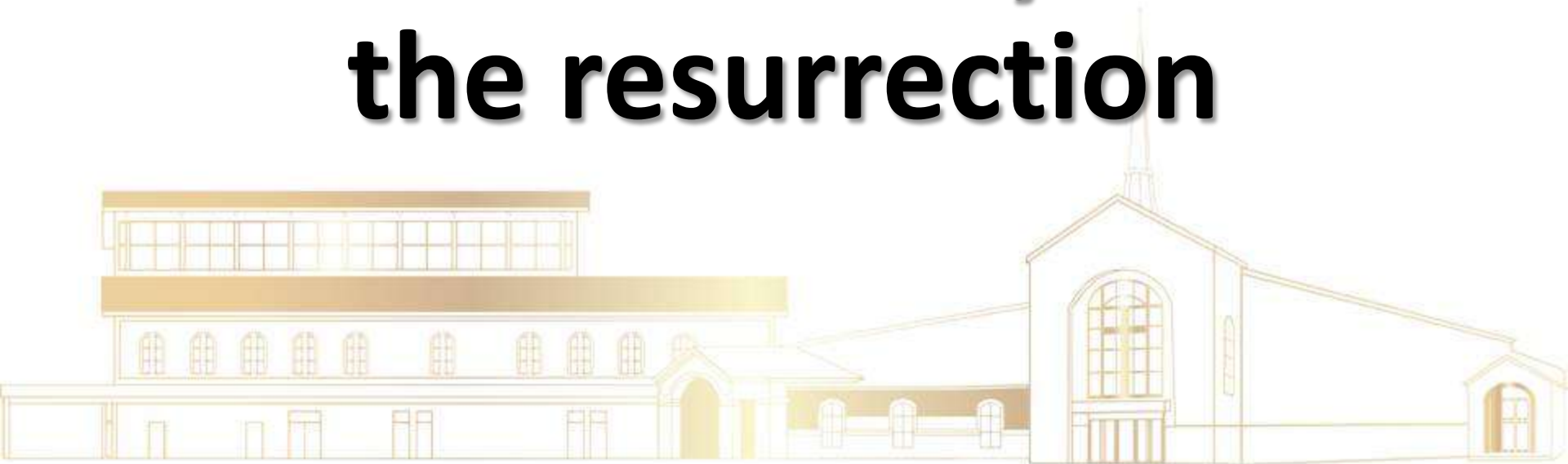
# Revelation 21:4

# Matthew 6:19-20 (ESV)

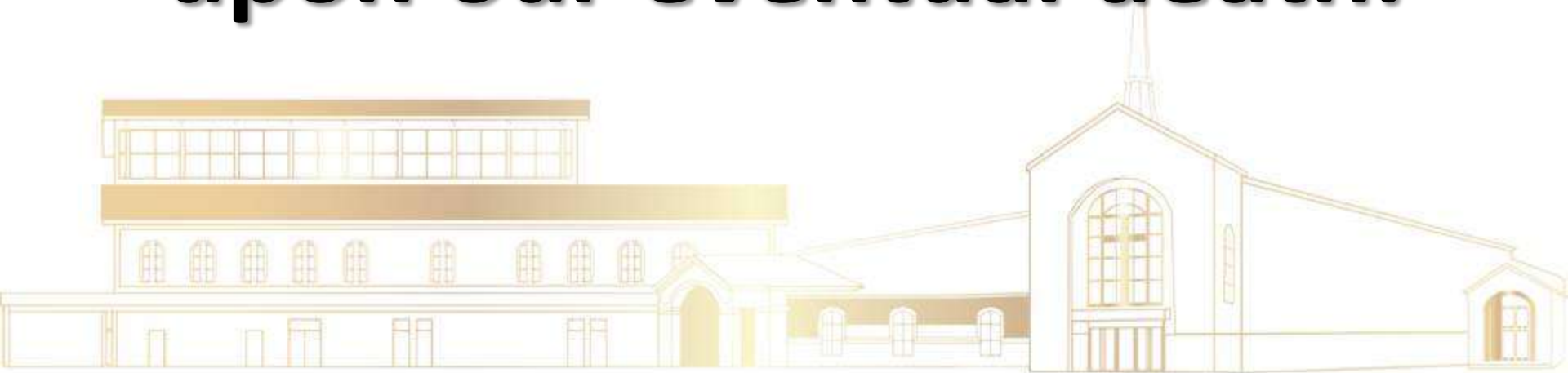

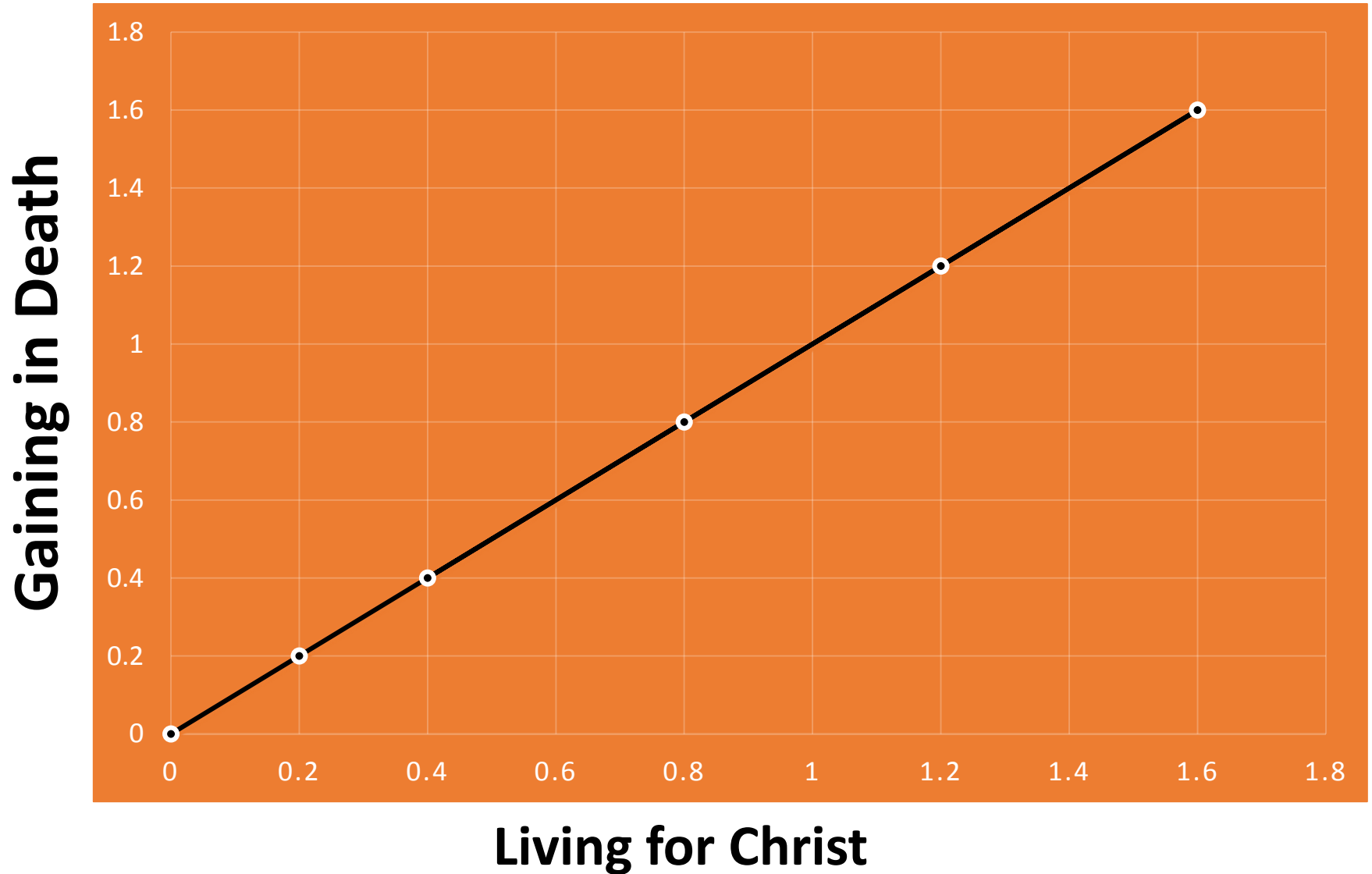


# Luke 12:33 (ESV)

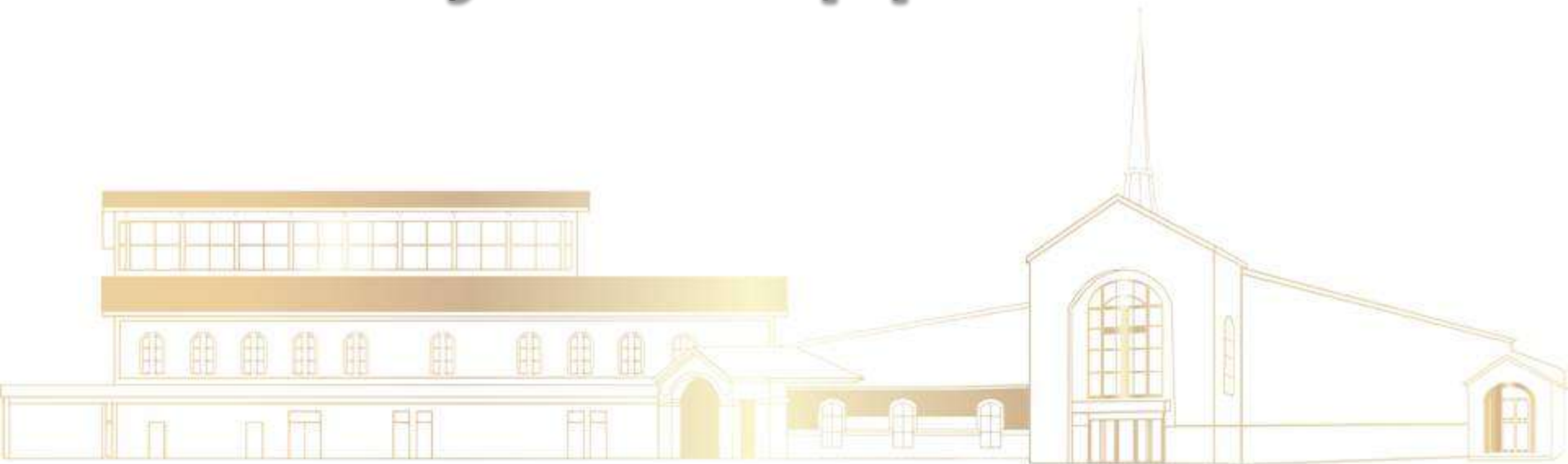
# Romans 1:13

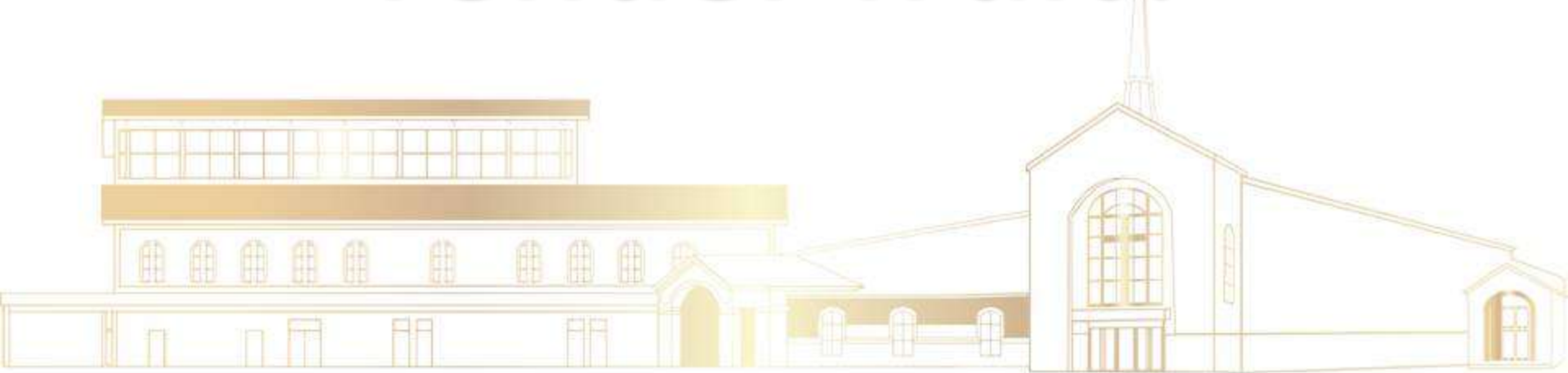

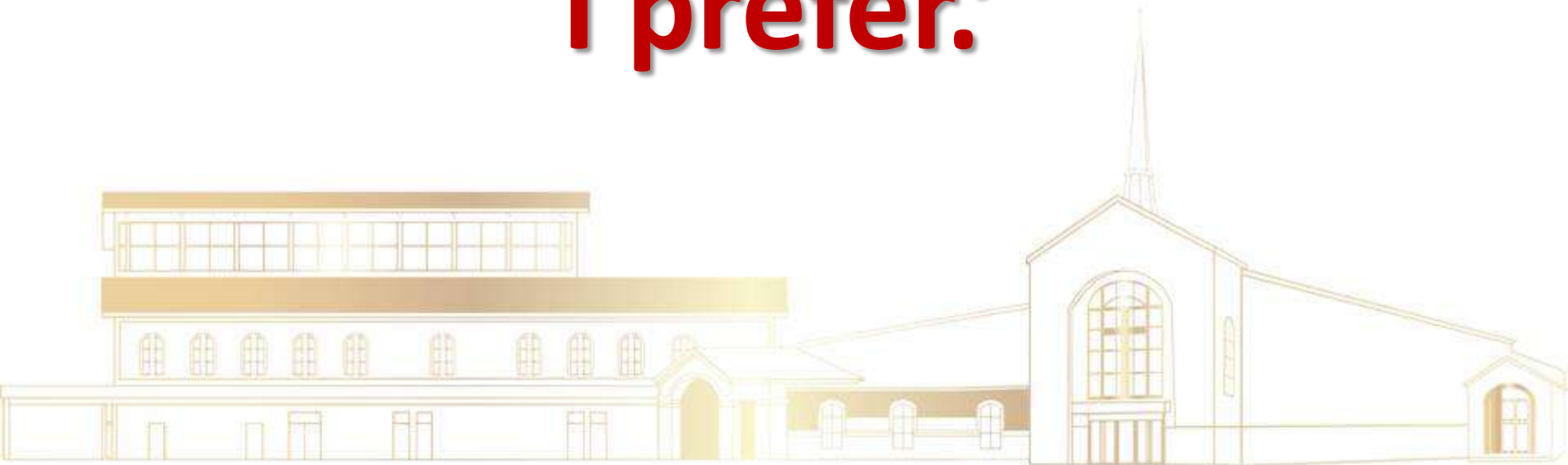

# Philippians 1:26

- That your **rejoicing** may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again.

KJV Translation Count — Total: 11x

The KJV translates Strong's G2745 in the following manner: rejoicing (4x), to glory (3x), glorying (2x), boasting (1x), rejoice (1x).

ESV

NET

- so that what you can be proud of may increase because of me in Christ Jesus, when I come back to you.
