A Synagogue




Synagogue Architectural Plan










Luke 4:34

- “Ha! What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God.”


The **“Holy One of God”** description is

Luke 4:35


- But Jesus rebuked him, saying, **“Be silent and come out of him!”**
- And when the demon had thrown him down in their midst, he came out of him, having done him no harm.




Luke 4:36

Turn to Luke 20


One day, as Jesus was teaching the people in the temple and preaching the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders came up ² and said to him, **“Tell us by what authority you do these things, or who it is that gave you this authority.”** ³ He answered them, **“I also will ask you a question. Now tell me, ⁴ was the baptism of John from heaven or from man?”** ⁵ And they discussed it with one another, saying, **“If we say, ‘From heaven,’ he will say, ‘Why did you not believe him?’ ⁶ But if we say, ‘From man,’ all the people will stone us to death, for they are convinced that John was a prophet.”** ⁷ So they answered that they did not know where it came from. ⁸ And Jesus said to them, **“Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things.”**


Luke 4:37

- Now Simon's mother-in-law was ill with a high fever, and they appealed to him on her behalf.







- Now when the sun was setting, all those who had any who were sick with various diseases brought them to him, and he **laid his hands on every one of them and healed them.**




Luke 4:41




