## The Eternal Gospel of Jesus Christ

The eternal<sup>1</sup> gospel<sup>2</sup> is the good news<sup>3</sup> that God is redeeming<sup>4</sup> and reconciling<sup>5</sup> sinners<sup>6</sup> to Himself eternally<sup>7</sup> through the sacrificial<sup>8</sup> and substitutionary<sup>9</sup> death, burial, and resurrection<sup>10</sup> of the man<sup>11</sup> Christ<sup>12</sup> Jesus through authentic<sup>13</sup> faith<sup>14</sup> in what Jesus,<sup>15</sup> the one and only<sup>16</sup> sinless<sup>17</sup> Son of God<sup>18</sup>, accomplished<sup>19</sup> on a tree<sup>20</sup> in the city of Jerusalem<sup>21</sup> 2000 years ago<sup>22</sup>.

## **Gospel Glossary**

Authentic: that which is real, true, genuine and from the heart Christ: the promised king<sup>23</sup> and deliverer<sup>24</sup> of the Jews, Messiah<sup>25</sup>

Crucify: to put to death by nailing or binding to a cross

Faith: belief and trust in Christ alone and the salvation He provides<sup>26</sup>

God: the Supreme eternal triune<sup>27</sup> Being who created everything and governs all things<sup>28</sup>

Gospel: the message of salvation<sup>29</sup> found in Jesus

Jesus: the second Person of the triune God who is fully God<sup>30</sup> and fully man born of a virgin<sup>31</sup>

Reconcile: bring back to a former state of harmony, to eliminate hostility<sup>32</sup>
Redeem: to free from the consequences of sin including the wrath of God<sup>33</sup>

Sacrificial: the death of Jesus as a sin offering to God

Salvation: deliverance from the power of sin and punishment in hell<sup>34</sup>

Sin: any violation or trespass of God's law<sup>35</sup>

Sinners: individuals who acknowledge their guilt before God and their need for a Savior<sup>36</sup>

Substitutionary: Jesus taking the place of sinners Tree: the cross on which Jesus was crucified<sup>37</sup>
