Pastor Sean's Note:



Let's talk about making disciples (see Matthew 28:19).

Jesus told us, through the apostles, to make disciples of all nations. Our goal is to reach people of all ethnicities with the gospel and the Word of God. And we must have as our first priority to make disciples. The command is not to make converts, but to make disciples. Every believer is converted, but they are also to be a follower that helps others to become followers of Jesus. We want to see males and females, whom God made in His image, starting to reflect Christ's image in Christlike transformation.

We assemble each week in large group sessions for worship through singing and preaching and I am striving to make the preaching of God's Word a disciple-making session. But discipling through a large group is limited in its effectiveness because of the lack of relational two-way communication. The more personal disciple-making is, the higher likelihood that it will be effective.

Disciple-making effectiveness can be measured as people examine their own lives to see if they are actually making disciples of Jesus. It is that simple, are we bearing fruit? Jesus says in John 15:8, "By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples." Who are the lost people we are having Gospel conversations with, and who are the believers that we are helping to grow in Christlikeness so that they can go and do the same for others?

We assemble at 5pm for another large group session, but within this large group, there is a conscious effort to increase two-way communication and participation, which we believe will increase effectiveness. We talk. I ask questions. Multiple people answer. The goal is to increase engagement, ownership, personal application, and, thus, effectiveness.

We gather on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights (and other times) for small group Bible study. In these small groups, we encourage maximum participation. This is NOT another preaching session. Teachers who minimize two-way communication and max out on one-way lectures operate contrary to the culture we are trying to create. The goal is to set the conditions for everyone to be able to ask and answer questions and interact with the Word of God and its application for Christlike transformation.

This is a culture that we are striving to create within Berean. Please join in and help us.

One final area we have yet to arrive at is micro groups. A micro group is 2 to 5 gender-specific people, consistently meeting to grow as disciples. Again, Christlike transformation is the goal. When God saved you, He transformed you into a new creation in Christ (2Co 5:17). As new creations, the goal is to grow more like Christ in our being, manifested in Christlike communication, thinking, and actions (those 4 elements should sound familiar). You will hear more about micro groups in the coming months.

One idea I have had for micro groups, 2-5 men or women, is to meet on campus on Wednesday nights to go over the Sunday morning message. In this micro group, everyone would have heard the sermon, taken notes during the preaching, and a discussion would happen over the main text and supporting texts in the sermon. Questions could be asked and answered. More discussion about application could happen in an individualized sense and literally on and on.

Is this something that would appeal to you?
