Pastor Sean's Note:



We, the church, each believer, have been given a mission from our LORD and Savior, Jesus Christ, to make disciples (Mat 28:18-20) and Jesus did it by establishing personal relationships with individuals, focusing them on the kingdom of God—or the rule of God in the life of the follower of Christ.

And nothing has changed with the commission—Christ gave it and it is still in force. God still expects it from each of us.

For me, two words can summarize what I need to be about: “relational discipleship”. I did not coin these two words. Others before me and others afterward will use them. But I think these two words communicate quite nicely where our focus needs to be—not our sole focus or only focus. For example, I still need to be focused on sharing the gospel, and preaching the Word, and loving my wife, but interestingly, even these have an element of relational discipleship. What I am highlighting is my need to be intentional about doing life in relationship with others with the objective of growing disciples who make disciples.

When Jesus says ‘Go...’, I take that to mean “as you are going,” or as you are doing life. Thus, as I DO life, I don’t do it ALONE. I don’t live as a hermit. I don’t just associate with people who are in the same places as me. I want to do it with others in relationships. Who are you in relationship with where the objective is making disciples?

Most feel like they are not at the point in their walk with the Lord to be a “discipeler” (new word). The reality is you are missing a chance to grow yourself. In relational discipleship, both grow or all grow. Those are just the facts. If you do not feel ready to be a discipeler, then seek out someone to discipeler you so you can be a discipeler.

If you want to be more of a disciple yourself, then commit to relational discipleship. Find someone and ask them to be in a disciple-making relationship with you. You can begin by meeting with another person(s) with some level of regularity and intentionality. Using the Bible as your foundation, you will talk, ask and answer questions, share prayer requests, and talk through an area where Christ is transforming you and where you desire to go. Jesus said, “teach them to observe everything I have commanded you.” The goal is simple: learn all that Christ commanded and then diligently work to obey what he commanded, this is Christlike transformation.

Like this,

- 1) apply what you know
- 2) seek to learn more
- 3) apply more and the Holy Spirit guided and empowered cycle continues.
