Our Covenant

As a bond of unity among us, Berean Baptist Church accepts for its members the following covenant:

Having been led by the Holy Spirit to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior and upon our profession of our faith in Him, having been baptized in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, we do now solemnly and joyfully enter into this covenant with one another as one body in Christ.

We further realize that if we should fail to live up to the promises we have made, our brothers and sisters in Christ will always strive for our reconciliation and spiritual restoration. However, if we partake in a sustained and unrepentant violation of an Article of Faith, we will be brought under church discipline in accordance with the Church Constitution.

We make this covenant with each other for the express purpose of glorifying God as the visible representation of the body of Christ.

This prayer booklet is to help you in your talking and listening with God. Developing a quality prayer closet time can be quite challenging. “But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.” (Matthew 6:6). We can get distracted or not remember prayer points off the top of our heads.

This is not to be thought of as an exhaustive or complete list of points to pray on, but a guide to be able to grow as a prayer warrior. This systematic outline can help you keep track of your important prayer points. Feel free to add, delete, or change in any way, as the Lord leads you. Throughout the booklet, space has been left for you to add your prayer requests and make this guide more personal. There are also reminders to pause and listen for God speaking to you. Hearing from God can be more important than him hearing from you.

“May my prayer be set before You as incense, the raising of my hands as the evening offering.” (Psalm 141:2)

This stained glass paints the picture of how our prayers are received by God. They are a fragrant aroma to God. In OT times, burning incense was part of their worship of God. Prayer is part of our worship of God.

Prayer is considered to be a Holy Habit or spiritual discipline. As a maturing or fully functioning disciple of Jesus, growing a strong prayer life is critical. At Berean, you will often hear disciples described as fully functioning followers of Christ. As an illustration, let's look at Matthew 4:19, “And he said to them, ‘Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.’” As we follow Jesus, we must think like Jesus, and we gain this through His Word (Head). We are being made into Jesus as we worship Him through our life (Heart). We are personal and relational disciple-makers as we join Jesus in His work (Hands). Lastly, we point people to Jesus as we live and share the gospel as His witness (Feet). Prayer should help you to mature and grow in all four of these areas.



To help you organize your prayer points, this prayer booklet is based on the PAINT acronym. Each letter, P-A-I-N-T, links to an area, a posture, or aspect of prayer.

PAINT the Picture of my Heart and Life before God through Prayer!

Praise – Tell God how great, powerful & awesome He is.

Ask forgiveness – Repent & ask God to take the sin out of your life.

Intercession – Ask God to help and work in the lives of others.

Name hearts desires – Ask God to help and work in your life.

Thanksgiving – Thank God for everything He has given & done for you.

As you paint each stroke of your life picture, remember to pause to LISTEN to God.

Daily, Weekly, and Monthly

God provides us with many life opportunities to pray and listen to Him about. This is why God commands us to, “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.” (1Th 5:16-18). Strong relationships need communication. We need to be in constant communication with God. Allowing the Holy Spirit to prompt our spirit at any moment. Along with unceasing prayer throughout the day, there is also that time when we enter our prayer closet for focused prayer.

It would be impossible to pray through everything in our lives in our prayer closet moments, so this guide has been made to help you spread out all your prayer concerns, so nothing is missed. This way, you will have confidence that you have remembered to pray for everything God has placed on your heart.

To organize the spreading out of your prayer points, this prayer booklet has 3 sections: “Daily”, “Weekly”, & “Monthly”. The “Daily” section is designed to be used every day. Here is where you place all prayer points you want to lift up to God as regularly as possible. The “Weekly” section is designed to give prayer points for each day of the week. These would be prayer points that you might not lift up daily, but want to lift them up at least once a week. The “Monthly” section is designed to give prayer points for each date of the month. As a church, we are highlighting the reading of prayers from the Bible and using them in our personal prayer time in 2022. So, under each date you will find a prayer straight from Scripture and a suggested direction to pray. There is also blank space for you to be able to place prayer points, that you want to pray for at least once a month. It is impossible to pray for everything that we need to, or promise to, every day. But by prioritizing and placing all the items you wish to pray for in the different sections, you will be able to pray for each item at least once a month.
